

**TOWN OF PLOVER – MARATHON COUNTY  
MONTHLY MINUTES – JULY 14<sup>TH</sup>, 2020 6:30 P.M.**

**\*\*6:35 P.M.** Meeting called to order by Chairman Tony Kautza.

**\*\*Public Comments or Concerns:** None.

**\*\*Monthly Expenditures:** Signed and approved.

**\*\*Budget:** Per motion from Scott; seconded by Pete; passed to accept as printed.

**\*\*Road Report:** All roads have been mowed. Trees need trimming. Truck needs oil \$13.80 gallon – 5-gallon drum suggested. Digging done on Blue Willow. Water level is high on Old Lake Road; Scott will inspect and question resident about culvert replacement.

**\*\*Old Business:** Pete presented bill from Birnamwood Fire Department. 2 bills from Dells, 1 from Asplundt. Tony gave Clerk bill for barn fire at Sveener on Red Granite Road to pay \$1,100.00.

**\*\*New Business:** 1) Valerie presented Advanced Disposal possible contract for 3-year renewal; \$33 per ton. Prior contract stated 250 residents being serviced; must update this count. Also contract must state pick-up times and what day of the week. Must be a spring pick up. Bids must be posted and reviewed before a meeting.

2) Road Work: Red Granite Road – need to publish bid for footage. If over \$60,000 engineer must be involved. If \$50,000, can possibly use TRIP funding.

3) Chairman presented ordinance for Clerk/Treasurer Appointment to be placed on November ballot. Larry Mortenson stated this appointed Clerk could work for three townships. Scott made motion to put on ballot; Pete seconded; passed.

4) Permit for salt/sand shed was noted as received. Other permits were reviewed.

5) Clerk presented her resignation; she will work through the August 11<sup>th</sup> election and then complete resignation.
