**\*\* 6:30 P.M.** Meeting called to order by Chairman Tony Kautza.

**\*\* Minutes:** Minutes from May 14th, 2019 meeting read and approved per motion from Scott; seconded by Pete; passed.

**\*\* Public Comments or Concerns:** Valerie Parker questioned Neighborhood Watch handlers and funds in account. Connie questioned Schairer's use of heavy loads on North Pole Road.

**\*\* Monthly Expenditures:** Motion by Pete; seconded by Scott; signed and approved.

**\*\* Roads Report:** Eau Claire River Road ready to Chip Seal; new culvert installed by Sandberg's; mowing to start soon; Hatchery road fine after ditching was done; Red Granite has wet spots.

**\*\* Old Business:**

- 1) Resolution for Tulpan rezone signed and approved.
- 2) Audit: Kerber Rose submitted bid to review books—will be discussed in fall.
- 3) Resolution 6-19 signed and approved to abandon Little Plover Drive.
- 4) ATV/UTV signage: Ordinance will be typed up and signed at next meeting.

**\*\* New Business:**

- 1) Truck loan will go through CoVantage.
- 2) Motion by Scott; seconded by Pete; to approve sale of old truck to Langlade County for \$38,000.; passed.
- 3) Bill for road gravel was presented \$10,692.14. Clerk was advised to pay this month.
- 4) Pressure washer: Bill approved and signed.
- 5) Culvert on Eau Claire River Road still in process.
- 6) Concrete in front of Town Hall to be addressed later.
- 7) Red Granite Road: Two complaints have been issued by Ron Krueger. Rick has been grading it; and will discuss road work on it next year.

**\*\* Zoning issue:** Clark on Hatchery Road – too many horses – being handled by Marathon County.
