It's time to GO BIG! We are thrilled to bring back this show and exhibit artwork that makes a BIG impact. If you create large scale art that can be wall hung, this is the show for you. We will be accepting single works of art in a size range of 850 to 2,500 square inches. This translates to standard canvas sizes from 24"x36" to 48"x48." Multiply the length times the width of your art to determine the square inches. Total size includes frame. Installation will be on May 20, so get creative and GO BIG! **Due to space limitations, work will be accepted on a first come/first served basis.**

The North Shore Art League is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to enriching the human spirit and life of its community through art education, exhibitions and events. Classes are offered for adults and children by the League's distinguished faculty. In addition to our main studio, the League houses a premier printmaking program. Our national fine arts juried show, Art in the Village, is held each summer in Hubbard Woods Park in the bustling design district along Green Bay Road in Winnetka. **The dates for our 2025 show are Saturday & Sunday, June 21st & 22nd, 2025.**

Requirements:

- SIZE – Single works of art in a size range of 850 to 2,500 total square inches (24"x36" to 48"x48"). Total size includes frame and must weigh no more than 25 lbs. Glass is not allowed on framed works for this show.
- Works must be original, executed by the artist. No giclees, notecards or stationery; prints must be original. Collage or original digital images are appropriate.

• ARTWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF NOT WIRED FOR HANGING OR STILL WET AT DROP-OFF

- Pieces must remain for the length of the show. Sold pieces will be noted to be picked up at the end of the show.

Eligibility:

- The show is open to all artists 18 years or older who submit one 2D artwork.

Fees:

- One piece per artist: \$40 members; \$50 non-members. Includes both in-person and online exhibit!

North Shore Art League is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization.

Art Categories:

- Paintings: watercolor, gouache, oil, acrylic, mixed media
- Drawings: pastel, charcoal, graphite, mixed media, colored pencil
- Printmaking: monoprint, mezzoprint, drypoint, etching, collagraph and polyester lithography
- Photography
- Mixed Media

Sales:

- The North Shore Art League collects a 25% donation on the sale of any piece. The League will handle sales and remit the price, less the donation, to the artists at the end of the show. Required 9% IL sales tax will be added to all purchases.

Drop-off:

- Artwork dropped off prior to 5/20/25 will be subject to a \$10 EARLY DROP-OFF FEE.

Pick-up:

- Artwork not picked up by 1:00 on 7/15/25 will be subject to a \$10 LATE PICK-UP FEE.
