Re: NEED your ZOOM Class Supply List

Linda, did I ever answer this email request requesting my supply list for the Zoom class?

Do we have enough enrolled to hold the class?

If not, here it is:

Transparent watercolor tubes (5 ml size tubes are ok to start with)

Permanent rose, Prussian Blue, Winsor yellow, neutral tint or Paynes Grey (not both)

Watercolor brushes, these have shorter handles than brushes used for oils or acrylics. You need brushes with a good point on them.

#6 round, 1/2 inch flat.

Watercolor paper, 140 lb. Cold press. 9 x 12". Cotton rag paper is preferable as it takes the paint better than cellulose paper. I use Arches tablet (not block), Blicks has cotton watercolor paper, as does Lanaquarelle. If you want something less expensive to start with, Strathmore series 400 is the best quality they make. It has a brown cover.

Palette: mine is a 10 x 13 plastic rectangle with lots of areas for mixing different colors.

I think you can find a smaller version that is about 6 x 13.. They're available online or at Michael's and are not expensive. In a pinch, you could use a white porcelain plate that's at least 10 inches in diameter.

Misc: a #2 pencil, I use a mechanical pencil because it doesn't need to be sharpened. A soft white eraser; two containers for water, I use a large yogurt container; soft paper towels, or Kleenex
