DETAILED SAFARI ITINERAY



Day 1

Drive to Ndotu (Ngorongoro Conservation Area)

Upon arrival at the airport, you will be met by your driver-guide and begin your journey toward the breathtaking southern plains of the Serengeti ecosystem. The drive takes you through the Ngorongoro highlands, offering sweeping views, lush forests, and Maasai villages scattered along the route.

Upon reaching **Ndotu**, located within the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, you enter one of the most wildlife-rich regions during this season. January marks the beginning of the **Great Migration calving period**, and the plains come alive with thousands of wildebeest, zebras, and predators following closely.

Midday Lunch

You will stop at a scenic spot in Ndotu to enjoy a freshly prepared picnic lunch served with soft drinks. Relax under the shade of an acacia tree while watching herds spread across the open plains and listening to the natural sounds of the bush.



After lunch, continue with an afternoon game drive, exploring Ndotu's marshlands, woodlands, and wide-open plains—one of the few areas where off-road driving is allowed, allowing closer wildlife encounters.

Arrive at **Lake Masek Tented Lodge** in the late afternoon. Check in and enjoy a peaceful evening with views over the lake. Dinner will be served at the lodge's dining area.

Day 2

Drive to Lemala Nanyukie Camp (Central Serengeti)

After breakfast at Lake Masek Tented Lodge, depart Ndotu and begin a scenic drive toward the **Central Serengeti**, one of the most iconic wildlife areas in Africa. Along the way, experience the gradual change in landscape—from the flat calving plains of Ndotu to the rocky kopjes and savannah woodlands of Seronera.

Game viewing continues as you journey through the park, with opportunities to spot lions lounging on rocks, cheetahs scanning the plains, giraffes browsing acacia trees, and elephants moving gracefully through the grasslands.

Midday Lunch

Around midday, you will enjoy a picnic lunch served with chilled soft drinks at a designated picnic site in the Serengeti. This restful break gives you time to enjoy the vastness of the plains and the wildlife that often roams nearby.



Continue with a game drive en route to **Lemala Nanyukie Camp**, an elegant and luxurious camp set in a prime wildlife area. Check in and unwind, followed by a delightful dinner surrounded by the sounds of the Serengeti.

Day 3

Full Day in Central Serengeti

Enjoy a hearty breakfast before setting out for a full day of game viewing in the world-famous **Central Serengeti**, known for its incredible predator concentration. Today you will explore various parts of the Seronera Valley, looking for lions, leopards in the sausage trees, hyenas, large elephant herds, and countless grazing animals.

The full day in the field allows you to move at your own pace and maximize wildlife sightings.

Midday Lunch

Your guide will select a safe and scenic spot for your picnic lunch served with soft drinks. Enjoy your meal while overlooking endless savannah and watching wildlife pass by in their natural rhythm.



In the afternoon, continue exploring the area, visiting watering holes, river valleys, and the iconic kopjes beloved by lions. After a rewarding day, return to Lemala Nanyukie Camp for relaxation, sundowners, and dinner.

Day 4

Drive Back to Ndutu (Lake Masek Tented Lodge)

After breakfast, depart Lemala Nanyukie and begin your return journey toward Ndutu. Enjoy a game drive en route, looking for wildlife along the way as you move from the central region back to the southern plains. The closer you get to Ndutu, the more likely you are to encounter huge herds of wildebeest and zebra as they spread out for grazing.

Midday Lunch

Arrive in Ndutu around midday and settle in for another scenic picnic lunch served with soft drinks. This is a perfect opportunity to relax and appreciate the beauty of one of the richest wildlife regions on the continent.

Spend the afternoon exploring different parts of Ndutu with another game drive. The area is excellent for spotting cheetahs, lions, and hyenas due to the abundance of newborn calves during this time of year.

Return to **Lake Masek Tented Lodge** in the early evening.

Day 5

Ngorongoro Crater Tour → Overnight in Karatu

After an early breakfast, depart Ndotu and head toward the legendary **Ngorongoro Crater**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often called the “Eighth Wonder of the World.” Descend 600 meters into the crater, entering a natural wildlife sanctuary teeming with animals.

The crater floor offers opportunities to see black rhinos, large tusker elephants, lions, buffaloes, hippos, zebras, wildebeest, and an array of birdlife. The scenery is spectacular, with open grasslands, acacia forests, and a soda lake that often hosts flamingos.

Midday Lunch

Enjoy a picnic lunch with soft drinks at the famous **Ngoitoktok Picnic Site**, overlooking a hippo pool. It’s a serene and picturesque spot where you can relax and enjoy your meal while watching hippos and water birds.

After lunch, continue exploring the crater before ascending the rim and driving to **Karatu Farm Lodge**. Check in, enjoy a farm-fresh dinner, and relax after a rewarding day.
