Scholarship Application for 2022

Scholarships are for tuition, fees, on campus room and board only.

Up to \$20,000 scholarship awarded for year 2 of a 2 or 4 year institution.

Renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study.

All scholarship amounts are calculated on college cost of attendance (tuition, fees, room and board only) minus other grants and scholarships.

Several scholarships will be awarded.

Please complete the application in its entirety.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered for scholarship awards.

Purpose: The LKS Educational Scholarship Foundation was established in 2018 by Larry K. Sharpf. It enables high school graduates who live in Marion, Benton, Linn or Lane County to continue their education at a state or private school, community college or trade school within the State of Oregon. It also awards scholarships to final year students at Linfield College who have attended high school in the above mentioned counties.

Eligibility:

In order to be considered for Year 2 LKS Scholarship, a candidate must:

- Be an LKS scholarship recipient in 2021.
- Be currently attending an undergraduate program at a Junior College, State College, Private College or Trade School in the state of Oregon.
- Must have a cumulative College GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Entering Year 2 at the same institution.
- Annual household income of \$75,000.00 a year or less (must provide last 2 pay stubs and copy of parents 2020 federal tax return or FAFSA documents). Apply at www.fafsa.gov
- Pass a background check and be in good standing at your current school.
- Resident of Oregon and a U.S Citizen.
- Must have taken enough credit hours required to be a full-time student in year 1 and maintain that status in year 2.
- LKS scholarships are available to individuals without regard to race, religion, national origin, gender, color, disability or age.
- Students who are receiving institutional, state and federal aid **that exceed the direct cost of tuition, fees, room and board** are excluded from the applicant pool for Foundation scholarships.

Application Process:

- Applications are available on the Larry K. Sharp Educational Scholarship Foundation website: **LKSScholarship.org**.
- Completed Applications for 2022 are due May 1, 2022.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in July 2022 via phone and mail.
- Once notified, the candidate has 3 days to respond and accept the scholarship award. If the selected candidate does not respond within the allotted time, another winner will be chosen.
- Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the chosen institution in the recipients name. No funds will be released directly to a recipient.
- Funds will not be dispersed until August/September 2022.
