All other scholarship amounts are based on estimated cost of year 1.

Several scholarships will be awarded.

Purpose: The LKS Educational Scholarship Foundation was established in 2018 by Larry K. Sharpf. It enables high school graduates who live in Marion, Benton, Linn or Lane County to continue their undergraduate education at a state or private school, community college or trade school within the State of Oregon.

Eligibility:

In order to be considered for LKS Scholarship, a candidate must:

- Be currently pursuing an undergraduate degree at a Junior College, State College, Private College or Trade School in the state of Oregon.

- Must have cumulative High School GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Annual household income of \$50,000.00 a year or less (must provide FAFSA form/access).
- Pass a background check.
- Resident of Oregon and a U.S Citizen.
- Live in Marion, Benton, Linn or Lane County.
- Must take enough credit hours required by chosen school to be a full-time student.
- Scholarship may be applied to tuition, room and board only.
- LKS scholarships are available to individuals without regard to race, religion, national origin, gender, color, disability or age.
- LKS scholarships are renewable and priority is given to previously awarded recipients for following years (up to 4 years) if college GPA remains a cumulative of 2.75 or higher.
- Students who are receiving institutional, state and federal aid **that exceed the direct cost of tuition, room and board** are excluded from the applicant pool for Foundation scholarships.

Application Process:

- Applications are available on the Larry K. Sharpf Educational Scholarship Foundation website: **LKSScholarship.org** or speak to your counselor.
- Completed Applications for 2019 are due May 3, 2019 8:00 p.m.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in June 2019 via email.
- Once a candidate is notified of winning, the candidate has 3 days to respond and accept the scholarship award. If the selected candidate does not respond within the allotted time, another winner will be chosen.
- Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to chosen institution in the recipients name. No funds will be released directly to a recipient.
