

She wanted to include ALL parents and provide a platform for ALL students to share their work with their family. The VAE grant allowed Ms. Bozung to teach students to use technology to create and share videos of themselves applying knowledge in the classroom through activities. The students love playing "teacher" on their videos and cannot wait to share their masterpieces with their parents. The students can share the videos at any time, with new videos added throughout the year. Parents can see their child participating, engaging, and learning at school. Ms. Bozung is a VAE CCG champion who is creative, innovative, inclusive, and intentional in all she does to serve students.


