Dark Green	1/4 yard
Light Gray	1/3 yard
Dark Gray	1/3 yard
White	1/4 yard
Black	1/3 yard
Purple	1/4 yard
Orange	1/4 yard
Red	1/4 yard
Binding	1/4 yard
Backing	1-1/4 yards

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Medium Green	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 - 4" x WOF strip. Fanfold over shape D. Subcut into 12 D pieces.
Medium Green	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 3 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
Dark Green	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 3 - 4" squares. Subcut into 12 E pieces.
Dark Green	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 – 3-1/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold over shape G. Subcut into 12 G pieces.
Light Gray	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 6 - 4" squares. Subcut into 24 E pieces.
Light Gray	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 – 5-1/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold over shape A. Subcut into 12 A pieces.
Dark Gray	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 3 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips.
Dark Gray	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 – 4-1/4" strip. Fanfold over shape C. Subcut into 24 C pieces.
Black	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 2 – 3-3/4" strips. Fanfold over Shape B. Subcut into 24 B pieces.
White	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 – 4-1/4" strip. Fanfold over shape C. Subcut into 24 C pieces.



Orange	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 3 - 3" squares. Subcut into 3 F pieces.
Red	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 1 – 3-3/4" strips. Fanfold over Shape B. Subcut into 12 B pieces.
Purple	GO! North Carolina Star-12" Finished (55605)	Cut 3 - 4" squares. Subcut into 12 E pieces.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 3 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

These are the piecing directions to make the block. For color placements see note underneath each step or the final diagram on the last page of the pattern.

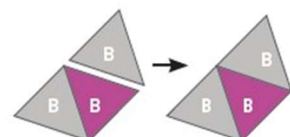
1. Sew 2 B pieces together to create BB units. Make 12.

COLOR: The light gray in the diagram will be black and the pink will be red.



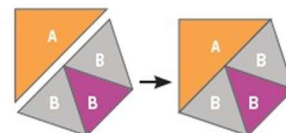
2. Sew a third B piece to BB to create BBB units. Make 12.

COLOR: The third piece will also be black.



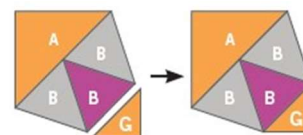
3. Sew Piece A to the long edge of BBB as shown. Make 12.

COLOR: Piece A will be light gray.



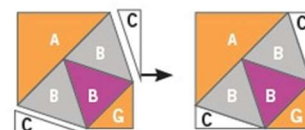
4. Sew Piece G to the opposite edges of ABBB as shown. Make 12.

COLOR: Piece G will be dark green.



5. Sew a Piece C to either side of ABBBG as shown. Make 12.

COLOR: Piece C will be white.



6. Sew a Piece C to either side of 1 Piece D as shown. Make 12.

COLOR: Piece C will be dark gray. Piece D will be medium green

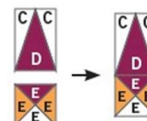


7. Sew 4 E pieces together. Make 12.

COLOR: top piece will be dark green. Bottom piece will be Purple. Side pieces will both be light gray.

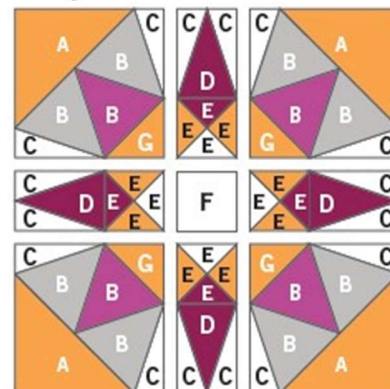
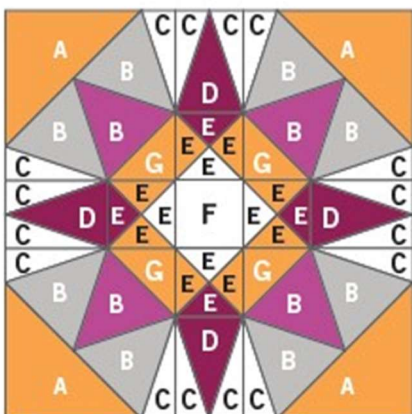


8. Sew the units from steps 6 and 7 together. Make 12.



9. Lay out units as shown and sew together. You can double check colors with the last page of the pattern.

10. Your block should measure 12 1/2" square.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out 3 blocks as shown in the quilt diagram. Sew blocks together.
2. Sew left and right dark gray border on. Start by measuring the height of the quilt. Then cut two of the strips to the same length. Sew to the left and right sides.
3. Sew top and bottom light gray border on. Measure the width of the quilt. Then cut the remaining strips to the same length. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
4. Repeat the above process to sew on medium green borders.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
