GO! Nine Patch Star- 9" Finished (55685)

GO! Strip Cutter – 3 1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)

Additional Dies (optional)

GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Blue	2 1/4 yds
White	1 yd
Red	1 1/2 yds

Additional Supplies:

Throw Size batting

2 yd 44" Backing Fabric

Cutting Directions:

****This pattern assumes fabric is at least 42" wide.**

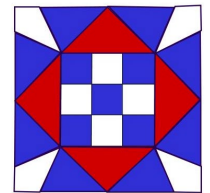
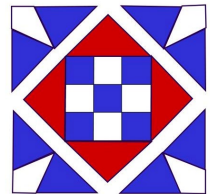
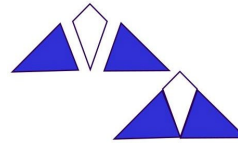
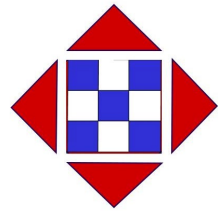
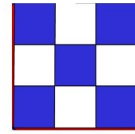
Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Blue	GO! Nine Patch Star - 9" Finished (55685)	Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on A. Cut 30 A squares.
		Cut (12) 4-1/2" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on D. Cut 144 D shapes.
Blue	GO! Strip Cutter – 3 1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)	Cut (2) 7-1/2" strips WOF. Place on die and cut (4) 3-1/2" strips for borders.
Red	GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut (2) 8-1/2" strips WOF. Place on die and cut (5) 2-1/2" strips. Set aside for binding.
Red	GO! Nine Patch Star - 9" Finished (55685)	Cut (3) 6" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on B. Cut 24 B shapes.
		Cut (3) 4" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on C. Cut 24 C shapes.
White	GO! Nine Patch Star - 9" Finished (55685)	Cut (2) 2 1/2" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on A. Cut 24 A squares.
		Cut (5) 4" strips WOF. Accordion fold and place on C. Cut 48 C shapes.

Sewing Directions:

Nine Patch Star Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 9" finished block. Make 6 blocks.

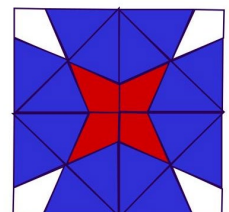
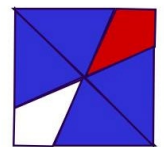
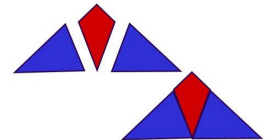
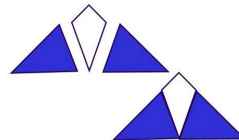
1. Sew the A squares together to create the center 9 Patch.
2. Sew the red B triangle to each side of the 9 Patch.
3. Sew a blue D triangle to both sides of the white C shape. Repeat 4 times.
4. Sew the D/C/D triangles to each side of the unit.



Angle Block

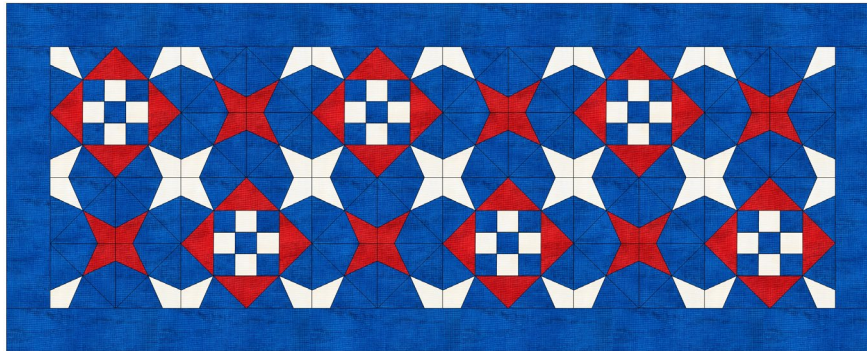
NOTE: Directions will be for one 9" finished block. Make 6 blocks.

1. Sew a blue D triangle to both sides of the white C shape. Repeat 4 times.
2. Sew a blue D triangle to both sides of the red C shape. Repeat 4 times.
3. Sew these triangle units together along the long edge to make four units.
4. Sew the four units together to make the block, with the red C pieces in the center.



Runner Assembly

1. Sew the blocks together, with the blocks alternating in the pattern.
2. Cut 1 border strip into (2) 18-1/2" strips. Sew these to the short sides of your runner.
3. Sew the remaining 3 border strips together, end to end. Subcut into (2) 60-1/2" strips.
4. Sew these to the top and bottom of your runner.



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between runner top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
