What reassures you? What is behind your life

plans? How do you cope with change? What does the Bible say about life? On October 8, we start a series of **Life Explored** experiences, looking through the Bible starting in Genesis and ending in Revelation. We're using interactive sessions centred around a collection of silent films from across the world creating "Nathan Moments"; as the prophet Nathan did for King David in 2 Samuel 12... worryingly challenging.

Life Explored offers the opportunity to consider varied questions that help us understand our search for fulfilment, and Jesus's offer of life in all its fullness. It's for confused Christians, convinced atheists, and **everybody** in between, providing a time to discover what Jesus has to say about the big questions of life that we wrestle with.

A typical evening will include:

- watching a short *Nathan Moment* video and sharing our reaction to it,
- watching a short video commentary on it,
- sharing a Bible reading (from Genesis to Revelation) and discussion questions

contrasting the God of the Bible with "gods" we all too easily give our lives to instead.

The series of seven sessions will run from Wednesday 8 October, weekly, and so finish on 19 November.

Our intention is each evening would last about an hour from 7.30pm, with light refreshments beforehand from 7pm. We suspect that due to numbers we would hold it in Cranstoun. So, as part of our ongoing TVP Christian Education programme, we have already completed Christianity Explored, Discipleship Explored, and Bible Explored... now we're doing Life Explored.
