that we may be set free by LOVE and know your true peace.

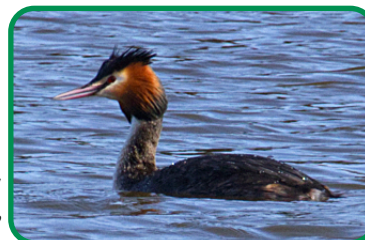
Saturday 25th - World Malaria Day
