MIDLOTHIAN FOODBANK

Back in March 2020 when Covid restrictions were being put in place, the Government increased Universal Credit by £20 a week. This was to be a temporary increase. Now 18 months on the Government is scrapping the £20 uplift. It is predicted that this will put a further 800,000 into the poverty category.

New data lays bare the full impact of the impending cut. Faced with a cut of £20 a week, 1.2 million people (20%) claiming Universal Credit say they will very likely need to skip meals and 1.3 million (21%) say they will very likely be unable to afford to heat their homes this winter. Nearly a million (900,000, 15%) say they are very likely to need to use a food bank as a result of the cut.

Imagine what it would be like to have had £20 a week for 78 weeks. It would have been included in your weekly budget. Now imagine what it would be like to lose £20 a week.

It is a sad reflection of our society that we need Foodbanks. Our local Foodbank in Gorebridge provides a vital service to those in need. Please keep your donations coming, in goods or cash. Thank you.
