### **APPLE PIZZA**

#### **1. PASTRY**

2 cups of flour  
½ tsp. salt  
2/3 cup shortening  
5 to 7 Tbsp. cold water

Roll out dough mixture and  
place on pizza pan. Flute edges.

#### **2. FILLING**

4-5 medium-sized apples  
½ cup sugar  
1 tsp. cinnamon  
½ tsp. nutmeg

Put thinly sliced apples in large bowl.  
Stir in sugar and spices. Mix  
thoroughly. Arrange evenly on pastry.

#### **3. TOPPING**

¾ cup flour  
1 cup sugar  
1/3 cup butter/oleo

Combine and mix until  
crumbly. Sprinkle over  
Apples.

Bake: 425 degrees, about 20 -25 minutes.

## *A Special Note...*

Beloved,

I have been asked recently to write about how we can approach one another in love when one of us is upset with another. While conflict is uncomfortable, it can be very healthy if addressed properly. Knowing how to do so, though, can be a significant challenge. Here is what I do know:

In Matthew 18:15-22 Jesus presents a model for healthy conflict within faith communities. The 2016 Book of Discipline contains the parameters for the structure and function of United Methodist churches. These are both resources which can teach us about how to address one another when concerns and/or conflicts arise. Here's a summary of what we ought to do when we are upset with an individual or individuals within the faith community:

1. Address the individual directly and privately (Matthew 18:15).
2. Utilize the systems in place within the church.
  - a. The Staff/Pastor-Parish Relations Committee (S/PPRC) is the committee designed (in part) to hear concerns about the well-being and effectiveness of the pastor and/or staff. Current members (through December 31) are: Phil Kugler, Christy Hall, Hope Lenhart, Terry Grimshaw, Lisa Spencer, David Hubbard, Jean Irwin, Marilyn Marks, Judy Farr, and Lori Giverson.
  - b. A Lay Leader is someone who could be approached with a concern about the state of the church and her ministries. Our current Co-Lay Leaders are Chuck Parker and Marcia Albrecht.

Additionally, there are committees which work on specific areas of ministry: the Worship Committee talks about Sunday Services and holidays, the Trustees address the needs of the church building and parsonage, the Finance Committee tends to the fiscal health of the church, and the Church Council oversees the whole mission and ministry of the church.

As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to transform the world. We can best do that by living courageously into the principles Jesus taught, even (especially) when doing so makes us uncomfortable. Jesus calls us to address one another directly when we are upset. If, for some reason, that is not possible the Book of Discipline does give us other options, as indicated above.

It is a joy to continue to grow in relationship with you. I pray that God will continue to inspire us to live boldly in our love for one another as we follow Jesus.
