From the Pastor

Dear Family and Friends of Mexico First UMC,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our beloved Savior, Jesus who is the Christ.

I am writing this in mid-March as the response to the COVID-19 Coronavirus is beginning. We are in the midst of dramatic changes as store shelves are stripped of merchandise, businesses are reducing services, schools are closing, and people are beginning to spend less time together. This is a strange season with unexpected changes for us all.

We reluctantly closed our building doors late in the afternoon on March 15th and will reopen at a later date. This was a heart-breaking decision to make after consulting with the leaders in our church and I appreciate their support in the process. I strongly believe that part of loving our neighbor is doing our part to control the spread of the virus so people stay healthy.

However, even though the building is closed and we are not holding meetings and events, we are still the body of Christ planted in the village of Mexico to love our neighbors! This is an opportunity for people to see the church reaching out and helping others even as the CDC calls for social distancing. That is avoiding crowds and places where people gather, as well as standing a slight distance apart from other people in an effort to avoid spreading germs.

But in this time of being socially distant, I urge you to stay connected with others. Text and call people to check in. Renew neglected relationships by writing letters or friendly emails. If you are running to the store, check with your neighbor to see if they need anything. If you have an abundance of something in your cupboards, share it with someone else. If you are able, donate to the food pantry or other local non-profits that feed the hungry. Be creative in reaching out to others.


DVD's Available
