One of the greatest blessings was seeing these two groups come together to raise money through the cardboard village for the homeless shelter in Oswego, Victory Transformation. Both men's groups continue to give to their churches and communities, but one of the greatest blessings was seeing them come together to have a very successful coat and chili giveaway that was free to our shared community. Our trailer park ministry at Lycoming continues to grow and be transformed under its new leadership of Miss Pat and her team, while the joint ministries of Mexico's Growth and Outreach Committees continue to give and share much needed material needs along with spiritual growth. Another one of the greatest blessings is to see both churches come together to help at Operation Reindeer where we helped close to 200 families and 600 children this year. Seeing this great need, we also begin to see the planting of seeds through a new lunch ministry in Mexico.

Family, as we leave a season focused on creating a sense of **Home**, not found in buildings, but in Jesus and us, His family, I would like to head into a season of **Hope and Light**, that will shine brightly from Jesus to us and through us. We as "One Church", need to point that **Hope and Light** outward and through that, God will grow this family. 

Mission Outreach Committee News

<u>Operation Christmas Child</u> – Shoeboxes from our church and Lycoming UMC (145 in total) were taken to a local distribution center to be sent to children all over the world by Samaritan's Purse. Our church has participated in this mission since 2007.

<u>Blessing Box</u> – The blessing box in the church parking lot continues to provide for our neighbors who need help with food and personal items on a daily basis. Most often, the box is emptied from day to day.

Some ideas to add to the blessing box include cereal, instant oatmeal, pasta, pasta sauce, peanut butter, shelf stable milk and toilet paper. With the cold temperatures this time of year, we need to be aware of the potential for things to freeze. This also means that we can be a bit more creative in what we add to the box if the temperatures are going to remain cold.

Church Growth Group by Sue Morton

The mission statement for this committee is: "With the teachings of the Gospel as a foundation, the Mexico First United Methodist Church Discipleship and Growth Group provides the tools and resources necessary to inspire people to build and/or strengthen their relationship with God." This dedicated church group meets on the last Sunday of the month right after the Sunday morning worship service.

We sponsor Open Mic Night, Family Fun Night, and have donated financially for the church AED, the Easter Egg Hunt, Vacation Bible School and the Halloween candy give away. The committee assisted with Operation Christmas Child, the Have a Heart program, and sponsored a paint class. The group also purchases The Upper Room bimonthly faith-filled publication distributed to church members. Welcome bags given to guests visiting our church are filled with church information and a mug, pen, and pocket cross in the hopes that these will encourage guests to join us in worship.
