From the Pastor...

Dear Family and Friends of Mexico First United Methodist Church,

Grace and peace to you in the Name of our Savior Jesus Christ.

It seems like Christmas was just a couple weeks ago, yet we are already beginning to think about spring! The Worship Committee met recently to plan our services for Lent, Holy Week, and Easter.

This season is a significant time in the Christian year because without Easter, Christianity would not exist. The suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ allows God and humanity to enter into a new covenant relationship allowing people to be freed from sin and born anew into eternal life with God.

The season of Lent is the 40 days (not counting Sundays) that lead up to Easter. In the early days of the Church, Lent was the end of several years of preparation for new converts to join. This final season of fasting and study culminated in baptism and the opportunity to take Communion for the first time. Over time, Church members began to join in the 40 days of penance and fasting as a means of renewing their baptismal vows. It was an opportunity for people to acknowledge areas where they had turned away from God so they could repent and turn back to God. Lent allows people the opportunity to recognize our need for a Savior.

Many people use the season of Lent as a time to be a little more intentional about their faith. Traditionally people will give up something in order to remember Jesus' sacrifice on the cross for humanity. Sometimes rather than giving up something, people will take up a new spiritual discipline. Perhaps they spend more time reading the Bible, or praying, or using silence and solitude as a means to hear God's voice.

We have scheduled two special worship services to allow you to celebrate Lent. They will provide opportunities to reflect, repent, and draw closer to God. Both services will be held in our sanctuary.

March 6 – 6:30 p.m. – Ash Wednesday Service. This service will include the traditional Imposition of Ashes as a sign of repentance.

April 19 – 7:00 p.m. – Community Good Friday Service. We will worship together with other churches from Mexico as we remember the final week of Jesus' life on earth.

April 21 – 10:00 a.m. – Easter Morning Service celebrating Christ's resurrection

I look forward to sharing our Lenten journey together this year!

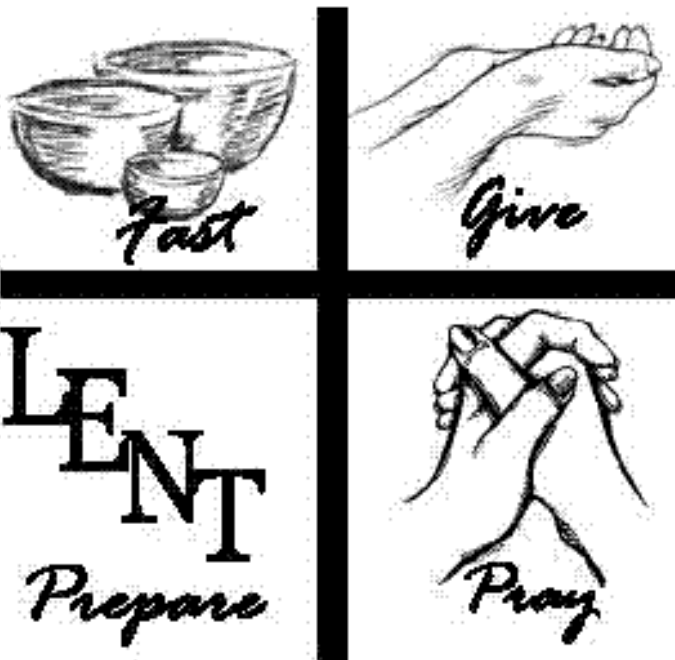

### Crock Pot Chicken Wing Dip

Carol made this dip for a January Coffee Hour, and was asked to make it again for the UMMen's Club Halfway Night. It was a hit both times!

#### Ingredients:

3-4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts-cooked  
2 (8 oz.) packages of cream cheese- softened to room temperature  
6 oz. of hot sauce  
1 bottle of ranch dressing  
2 cups of cheddar cheese

#### Directions:

Cook chicken breasts and then cut or shred chicken. Add to crock pot. Add hot sauce to chicken until all is covered (you may add more hot sauce if you like). Add cream cheese. Add bottle of ranch dressing. Set crock pot on low for 2-3 hours. Add 2 cups of cheddar cheese ½ hour before serving. Serve with corn chips like Scoops.

Gator Chili

Ernie made this chili and served it at UMMen's Club Halfway Night. A success – the recipe was requested for this newsletter!

Ingredients:

1 lb alligator andouille sausage (bulk or links may be purchased at Scriba Meats)
1 TBSP Chili Powder
½ tsp crushed red pepper (can be omitted)
½ tsp salt
1 pint tomatoes
1 14 oz can great northern beans
1 14 oz can dark red kidney beans
½ bag pepper and onion mix (frozen)

Directions:

Cook sausage until done breaking into chunks (if using links remove skin). Meanwhile combine canned tomatoes, beans, seasonings, and pepper and onion mix. Place all in a crockpot and cook on low for 6 hrs. or so. Serve with choice of bread, biscuits, or rolls.
