

The Metacomet Greenway:

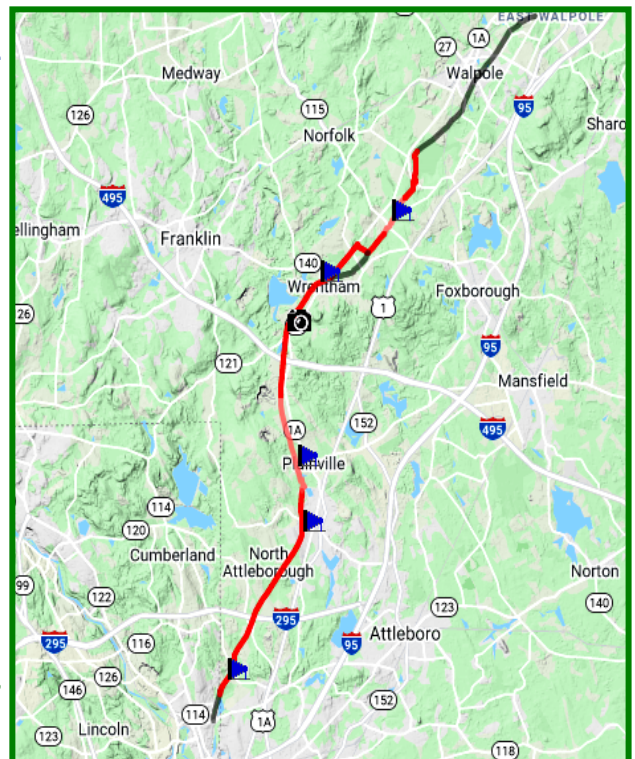

The Metacomet Greenway consists of a group of citizen volunteers who formed an organization in June of 2020 to explore the possibility and means of developing the former Old Colony Railroad into a safe, multi-use trail for nearby residents to enjoy. Across America, communities have developed rail trails to promote safe, alternative transportation; recreational activities; energy conservation; clean air; enhance a community's quality-of-life, residents' health and so much more. The Metacomet Greenway provides all this plus safe biking and walking routes, alternative paths to parks, & shopping, increased tourism, economic benefits, historical preservation, and a boost to residents' health and well-being.

The Metacomet Greenway's mission is to explore the best options for making these benefits available to our Towns' residents of all ages.
