Today, Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser declared a State of Emergency in Kenosha County in an effort to guard against the spread of COVID-19. Accordingly, the Kenosha County Division of Health has issued a list of recommendations. Among them, "Organizers of public gatherings of 50 or more people are encouraged to cancel these events, to reduce opportunities for person-to-person virus transmission."

The 2020 KAPDA Krawl Planning Committee has made the difficult decision to heed the recommendation and cancel the Krawl scheduled for March 14th and 17th. We felt that, as an organization made up of public safety professionals, it would be irresponsible of us to ignore the recommendation.

The Committee will be meeting soon to determine the future of this year's event. Thank you for your support of our organization during this unprecedented event.
