KEY HIGHLIGHTS – Five Essentials of Meditation: -- reference the YouTube video

- 1. Quiet space- no distraction you are already in the pavilions of God. This is a safe space. The devil does not know where you are.
- 2. Inner quietness- (Hint: If you are inhaling and exhaling breaths you are not thinking in the same space. This helps to allow those thoughts to pass. Don't entertain unwanted thoughts. Then begin with prayer of understanding to set the course for you and the Holy Ghost.
- 3. Close and continued thoughts center around the word of God, a scripture, topics, of something you need a clear understanding. Think of the scriptures that apply. If you do not know a scripture, go back to the model prayer. Matt 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- 4. Pray in the Holy Ghost interacting with God by alternating to silence as you spend time listening. Listening is the key: Here is this place God mysteries about what you asking is made clear. God will reveal his mysteries to you.
- 5. This is a personal active engagement with the Father alone. Meet him there daily.
