

BREED STANDARDS

General Appearance:

- Well balanced with good body length
- Well muscled
- Strong, large framed sheep
- Mature body weights:
rams 120-150 kg., ewes 80-100 kg.

Head:

- Polled
- Attractive clean open face
- White in colour
- Ears long and pendulous
- No wool around eyes or ears

Neck:

- No wrinkles or dewlap
- Well proportioned with head and body

Body:

- Long, deep, wide and well muscled with excellent loin eye
- Hindquarters full and well muscled

Feet and Legs:

- Set at corners with strong upright pastern
- Wool stops at the knees but covers the hocks

Fleece:

- Dense and fine up to 24 microns
- White, well crimped with medium to long staple
- No kemp or black fibres
