Action Items from the August 2021 Board meeting

- > Sheep industry feedback was provided to the National Farm Animal Care Council survey, reflecting on NFACC experiences.
- > A HayWest 2021 Facebook page was established to help connect hay/feed suppliers with those in the west needing feed. A spreadsheet of respondents was shared with supporters in the west helping with organizing feed supply.
- > Summer student contracts were extended by 2 weeks for IT staff, and 1 week each for Communications Manager and Economic Analyst positions.

Program Updates

Canadian Sheep Identification Program (CSIP) and Traceability

- AgroLedger Phase 2 development wrapped up in August. The team got an amazing amount of work done through the summer, resulting in completion of a foundational program that can support incoming traceability regulations while adding value to the system in terms of information sharing along the value chain.
 - Want to be able to scan an animal's ID and know it's date of birth?
 - Want to sell an animal and have its performance records available to future buyers when they scan the ID? 🗸
 - Need to track an animal's treatment records for vaccines, wormers or vet drugs and across multiple owners?



> The Canadian Sheep Federation was delighted to learn that our application to the University of Toronto's Interdisciplinary Capstone program was accepted, and the CSF team populated with an amazing group of young people. Project planning complete with deliverables and timelines will be completed in September. We look forward to this innovative project focused on bringing new technology into the livestock traceability realm.

Scrapie Flock Certification Program (SFCP)

- > In July, Connexion announced that Canada and Columbia have ratified a trade certificate for sheep and goats. The certificate will allow Canadian sheep and goat producers Certified in the Scrapie Flock Certification Program to ship live animals and embryos to Columbia.
- ➤ Changes in the Standard Operating Procedures for the program are pending approval by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency. The changes were included in the last National Standards Review discussion and are aimed at streamlining file processing. These include eliminating some duplication in record keeping and repeated reminder emails to enrolled producers. Once the SOP changes are finalized, a copy of the document will be available to producers on the program website www.scrapiecanada.ca

Chronic Wasting Disease Herd Certification Program (CWD HCP)

- > The annual Chronic Wasting Disease Herd Certification Program National Standards Review that took place through the spring, led to the release of a first draft of the amended National Standards this summer. The 2021 National Standards will come into force December 31, 2021, accompanied by updated Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and program forms.
- > CWD HCP enrolled producers are reminded that they are required to submit an annual application for advancement within 3 months of their anniversary quarter as indicated on program certificates. Annual applications must include an inventory report completed by the appropriate party and ALL program forms.


Industry Initiatives

- > Both the Government of Canada and the USDA hosted workshops in August with a focus on zoonotic disease surveillance and disease tracking, with emphasis on integrated disease surveillance platforms. The COVID pandemic shed light on the shortage of effective, real-time tracking of zoonotic diseases.
- As part of our Economic Impact Analysis, the CSF conducted an online industry survey over the course of the summer that garnered some really great feedback. The final report is expected to be released in time for the 2021 Annual General Meeting. Here are some highlights from the 200 responses we received:



Farms that Raise Animals Alongside Sheep




Distribution of Meat Destinations
