PROPOSED ORDER 2

**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE; INJUNCTION; ORDER APPOINTING
COMMISSIONER AS RECEIVER PENDING FURTHER ORDER OF THE
COURT; ORDER TO PRESERVE ASSETS OF INSURER**

On June 1, 2023, Petitioner, Scott J. Kipper, Commissioner of Insurance, State of Nevada (“Commissioner”) filed in this Court a Petition for Appointment of Commissioner as Receiver, Temporary Injunction, and other Permanent Relief (“Petition”) for Friday Health Plans of Nevada, Inc. (“Friday Health”) initiating this proceeding. On the same date, the Commissioner also filed a Motion for Injunction (“Motion”) to enjoin providers of

1 health care services to Friday Health members from interfering with their contractual
2 obligations and from interfering with the Commissioner's efforts to ensure Friday Health
3 members receive the health care services to which they are contractually entitled.

4 The Court, having reviewed the points and authorities along with relevant exhibits
5 filed in support of the Petition, including the consent of Respondent, finds good cause to
6 grant the Petition. The Court also finds that Friday Health's members are entitled to
7 continue receiving health care services under their health insurance contracts.
8 Accordingly, Friday Health is **HEREBY ORDERED** to appear and show cause why the
9 Petition should not be permanently granted on the 20th day of June 2023 at the
10 hour of 10:00 a.m./~~p.m.~~, Department 18 of the Eighth Judicial District Court, in
11 Las Vegas, Nevada

12 Pending permanent orders of the Court, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that

- 13 1. The Commissioner is appointed as Receiver of FRIDAY HEALTH with the authority
14 to enter the business and immediately oversee the operation and conservation or
15 rehabilitation of the business. NRS 696B.210, -.290.
- 16 2. Any and all persons are enjoined from the commencement or prosecution of any
17 actions by or on behalf of FRIDAY HEALTH, or against FRIDAY HEALTH. Further,
18 all persons are restrained from obtaining any preferences, judgments, attachments,
19 or other liens as to any property of FRIDAY HEALTH, or making any levy against
20 FRIDAY HEALTH or against their assets or any part thereof. NRS 696B.340, -.410.
- 21 3. All persons other than the Receiver are enjoined from disbursing, committing,
22 transferring, substituting, or withdrawing any funds from FRIDAY HEALTH's
23 accounts, or removing other property from, controlled, or owned by FRIDAY
24 HEALTH except as expressly directed or approved by the Receiver pending further
25 orders of the Court. NRS 696B.270.2.
- 26 4. FRIDAY HEALTH, the officers, directors, stockholders, members, subscribers,
27 managers, agents, employees, and all other persons are enjoined from: (1) wasting
28

1 or disposing of any assets or property of FRIDAY HEALTH, or (2) transacting any
2 further business on behalf of FRIDAY HEALTH except as expressly directed or
3 approved by the Receiver pending further orders of the Court. NRS 696B.270.1.

4 5. All providers of health care services, as defined in the policy of insurance, and any
5 other person that has provided or agreed to provide health care services to members
6 or enrollees of Friday Health, directly or indirectly, pursuant to any contract,
7 agreement, or arrangement for that purpose with Friday Health are permanently
8 enjoined from

9 a. Amending, changing, altering, or terminating any and all implied or express
10 contractual obligations or agreements.


11 b. Interfering in any manner with the efforts of the Receiver to assure that
12 Friday Health members and enrollees in good standing receive health care
13 services to which they are contractually entitled.

14 NRS 696B.270.

15 6. The Receiver is authorized to employ and to fix the compensation of such deputies,
16 counsel, employees, accountants, actuaries, investment counselors, asset managers,
17 consultants, assistants, and other personnel as the Receiver considers necessary.

18 NRS 696B.290.6.
