**ORDER SETTING CLAIMS FILING  
DEADLINE AND GRANTING  
RELATED RELIEF**

25 Petitioner, SCOTT J. KIPPER, COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE, STATE OF  
26 NEVADA as Receiver (“Receiver”) for FRIDAY HEALTH PLANS OF NEVADA, INC. (“Friday  
27 Health”), filed his Motion to Requesting the Setting of a Claims Filing Deadline and Granting  
28 Related Relief (“Motion”) on March 7, 2024. This Court heard the Motion on April 16, 2024, at  
10:00 a.m. Jerrell L. Berrios, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Receiver.

The Court, having reviewed the Motion, the papers and pleadings on file, and having considered the arguments made by counsel at the hearing, and noting that no opposition has been filed, and good cause appearing therefore, GRANTS the Motion. The Motion is granted for the reasons set forth in the Receiver’s motion and as unopposed under EDCR 2.20(e).

1 Based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that:

2 1. The proposed Proof of Claim (“POC”) procedure described in the Motion, including  
3 the forms and instructions attached as Exhibit 2 to the Motion, are approved and consistent with  
4 Nevada law pursuant to NRS 696B.330(1).

5 2. The proposed Receivership Appeal Procedure described in the Motion, including the  
6 form attached as Exhibit 3 to the Motion, are approved and consistent with Nevada law pursuant to  
7 NRS 696B.330(1) and NRS 696B.330(5)-(9).

8 3. The claim and appeal processing procedures described in Exhibits 2-3 comply with  
9 Nevada law and are within the authority granted to the Receiver by this Court’s Order Granting  
10 Petition for Appointment of Commissioner as Receiver and Nevada law.

11 4. The proposed notice procedures described in the Motion, including the form attached  
12 as Exhibit 1 to the Motion, are approved and the Court finds that notice procedures in the same or  
13 substantially similar form comply with requirements of Nevada law and due process.

14 5. The rights of parties regarding claims against Friday Health are fixed as of the date  
15 of the Liquidation Order pursuant to NRS 696B.400, except to the extent that the rights of claimants  
16 with contingent or unliquidated claims are protected by NRS 696B.400 and NRS 696B.450.

17 6. **July 31, 2024 is established as the deadline (“Claims Filing Deadline”) for filing**  
18 **and rendering absolute non-contingent and unliquidated claims against Friday Health.**

19 7. All claims against Friday Health not postmarked on or before July 31, 2024, and  
20 received at the address specified by the Receiver will be deemed not timely filed and shall be barred,  
21 not subject to processing by the Receiver, and ineligible to share in any distribution of the estate’s  
22 assets; Friday Health shall have no liabilities as to any such late-filed claims.

23 8. Claims which have not been rendered absolute (*i.e.*, both liquidated in amount and  
24 non-contingent) on or before the Claims Filing Deadline may not share in the estate’s assets, subject  
25 to any applicable exceptions found in NRS 696B.450, which will be in the Receiver’s sole discretion  
26 to determine.

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
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9. All other relief requested by the Motion is hereby granted.
