

**2026 PRESTON SPORTS RAFFLE RULES**  
**THIS VERSION OF PRESTON SPORTS RAFFLE RULES WAS GENERATED ON 3/31/2026**  
**ALL OTHER VERSIONS ARE OBSOLETE AND SHOULD BE DISCARDED**

1. **Sponsor** – The Cardinal Athletic Boosters (CAB), a 501 (c) 3 organization, is the sponsor and operator of the Preston Sports Raffle (PSR). The Preston Sports Raffle Committee (PSRC) conducts the raffle. The purpose of the PSR is to raise funds to support Cardinal School District Athletics.
2. **Eligibility** – Any person at least 18 years of age may purchase a ticket to be entered in the PSR. This person shall be known as the “ticket holder”. Preston Sports Raffle Committee (PSRC) members, and their spouses, are prohibited from purchasing PSR tickets, winning cash prizes, or the raffle Grand Prize. Preston Superstore employees are subject to their employer’s rules regarding the Preston Sports Raffle and are solely responsible for abiding by such rules.
3. **Tickets** – The cost to purchase a ticket for the PSR is \$20. (U.S. only). Each ticket has one number and represents one chance to win. There is no limit to the number of tickets sold. The number of tickets one person can purchase is unlimited. Online ticket sales will close at Midnight on October 1, 2026. In-person tickets will be sold up to the time of the drawing on the day of the event, at the discretion of the PSRC. Tickets are available at designated off-site PSR ticket locations (ticket sale sites as determined by CAB) and from designated individuals (members of CAB and/or the PSRC or their designees). Any unsold tickets become the property of CAB and will not be sold or used in the drawing.
  - **Multiple party tickets** – If more than one name is listed on a ticket stub, the first name listed shall be deemed the ticket holder. Delivery or payment of the prize shall be made solely to the ticket holder. It is the sole responsibility of the ticket holder to allocate any such prize among the participants in a multiple-party ticket, and CAB, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, and the members of the PSRC shall have no liability for any failure to do so.
4. **Failure of payment** – A ticket is not valid and shall not be entered in the PSR until satisfactory payment for such ticket is received by CAB. If a ticket holder’s payment by credit card is declined or a check is not honored by the bank for any reason, such ticket holder’s ticket shall be invalid and will not be entered in the drawing unless full and satisfactory payment is made by 8 pm on October 1, 2026; such payment to include returned check fees and any other penalties. In the event of the above-mentioned situation, CAB will endeavor to notify the holder of the invalid ticket by phone or email provided on the ticket stub. However, any failure to do so will not cause the ticket to become valid, cause the ticket to be entered into the PSR, or give rise to any claim or cause of action on behalf of the invalidated ticket holder.
5. **Rules** – By purchasing a ticket, each ticket holder, together with their heirs, administrators, executors, insurers, attorneys, and assigns, agrees to be bound by all the rules, limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth herein (“Rules”) as well as the applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. The PSRC’s decisions in all matters concerning the PSR and the PSRC’s interpretation and application of the Rules shall be final and non-appealable. CAB reserves the right to cancel or modify the PSR or the Rules for the PSR. The PSR is void where prohibited by law, and all federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.
6. **Early Bird drawings** – The PSRC will conduct a series of Early Bird Drawings, consisting of a \$500 cash prize monthly. A ticket will be drawn from a spinnable raffle device on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. A \$500 check will be issued to each winning “ticket holder”. The ticket stub will then be returned to the spinnable device, and it will be eligible for all remaining drawings of the PSR 2026, including subsequent early-bird drawings and the grand raffle. The 2026 Early Bird Drawings will be on the following dates: May 15, 2026; June 15, 2026; July 15, 2026; August 15, 2026; and September 15, 2026. CAB reserves the right to change the date, time, or place of any drawing if circumstances beyond CAB’s control mandate such a change. To be eligible for cash drawings, tickets must be purchased and payment completed by midnight the night before the cash drawings are drawn.

7. **Raffle drawing** – The *Grand Raffle drawing will take place on Friday, October 2, 2026*, at the Cardinal High School football game. The first ticket drawn will be the winner of the *Grand Prize, a 2026 Ford F250 SRW 4X4 Supercab* truck supplied by Preston Ford. There will be no cash equivalent prize offered. The ticket numbers will be randomly drawn from a spinnable raffle basket device. *TICKET HOLDERS NEED NOT BE PRESENT TO WIN*. The PSR committee will make every reasonable effort to notify winners as soon as possible by phone and/or e-mail. CAB reserves the right to change the date, time, or place of any of the drawings, including the grand raffle drawing, if circumstances beyond CAB’s control mandate such a change. Proper notice of any such changes will be announced in a reasonable and timely manner by CAB on the website [prestonsportsraffle.org](http://prestonsportsraffle.org). Prizes are non-transferable. The winner accepts the prize “as is.”
8. **Accepting/claiming a prize** – The grand prize winner must notify Cardinal Athletic Boosters of their decision to accept the raffled vehicle within 3 days of the drawing. Notice of the decision can be made by calling Cardinal Schools Athletic Director at 440-632-0261 x5007. All prizes must be claimed within 30 days of the drawing date or the date of the winner’s notification. Failure to claim a prize within 30 days from the drawing date or winner notification shall void the winning ticket holder’s right to the prize. A list of winners will be available on the PSR website at [prestonsportsraffle.org](http://prestonsportsraffle.org).
9. **Obligations of winning ticket holders** – Except as otherwise provided herein, each ticket holder who wins a prize is responsible for all costs associated with that prize, including but not limited to registration, licensing, and other applicable fees, as well as local, state, and federal taxes that may be applicable.
  - **Taxes**- Prizes valued at \$5000 or more require payment of federal taxes before taking possession of the prize. The value of the prize is included in the winner’s gross income and is subject to reporting by CAB to the IRS. It is suggested that ticket holders consult with a tax advisor to determine any tax liabilities associated with a raffle win. CAB assumes no responsibility for any prize winner’s tax liabilities. Each winning ticket holder is required to provide CAB with valid identification and a valid social security number and must complete all forms or payments necessary, before delivery of the prize. Failure to provide any information requested, failure to complete any form requested, or failure to pay the required taxes will constitute failure to claim a prize.
10. **Unclaimed Prizes**- If prizes are unclaimed within thirty (30) days of the Grand Raffle Drawing, another ticket will be drawn from a spinnable raffle device.
11. **Releases** – By purchasing a ticket, each ticket holder releases CAB, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, as well as the members of the PSRC from any injury, loss, damage, or liability associated with PSR, including, but not limited to, the selection process, interpretation and application of the Rules, and from any liability for injuries, loss, causes of action, or damages of any kind caused by any prize, or resulting from the acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize. Each ticket holder, together with their heirs, administrators, executors, insurers, attorneys, and assigns, agrees to indemnify and hold CAB and the PSRC harmless from any losses, damages, causes of action, rights, claims, and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the ticket holder’s acceptance or use of any prize.

Each ticket holder agrees that their name, likeness, and any statement made by them regarding any prize may be disclosed to and used by news media, and may otherwise be used by CAB for advertising or publicity purposes without compensation, and in lists of prize winners which may be published in area newspapers and other media.
