We hope this newsletter finds you well. We have several important updates and reminders for you.



GATE PROJECT:

We're excited to announce that construction on our automated gate project will begin next month! After years of planning, pricing discussions, and valuable homeowner input, we're ready to move forward. The County has approved widening our entry road off Los

Ranchos Road to allow two incoming lanes—residents will use the right lane, visitors

the left. Construction should take about three months. On some days, one road may close, requiring two-way traffic on the other. Joseph, our guard, will manage traffic—please drive slowly for everyone's safety. We'll continue 24/7 guard service and are forming a committee to help residents transition to the new system. ROAD REPAIR AND PAVING:

We wanted to give you a heads-up about some upcoming street maintenance in our community. Starting in late June, we'll begin pothole repairs on Greystone and rebuild the curb at Greystone and Hanover to improve street drainage. Then, during July and August, all streets will receive asphalt crack repair followed by a slurry seal coat to help preserve the pavement. To make this project go smoothly, we'll need everyone's help by moving cars off the affected streets during work. Each street will be impacted for about two days, so please plan accordingly. Thanks so much in advance for your cooperation! More information will be distributed before the work begins.
