Offering a MASS

"The offering of Mass for the repose of the soul of the faithful departed is linked with our belief in Purgatory. We believe that if a person has died fundamentally believing in God but with venial sins and the hurt caused by sin, then God in His divine love and mercy will first purify the soul. After this purification has been completed, the soul will have the holiness and purity needed to share in the beatific vision in heaven. While each individual stands judgment before the Lord and must render an account of his life, the communion of the Church shared on this earth continues, except for those souls damned to hell. The Vatican Council II affirmed, "This sacred council accepts loyally the venerable faith of our ancestors in the living communion which exists between us and our brothers who are in the glory of heaven or who are yet being purified after their death..." (Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, No. 51). Therefore, just as we pray for each other and share each other's burdens now, the faithful on earth can offer prayers and sacrifices to help the departed souls undergoing purification, and no better prayer could be offered than that of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass."

Ofrecimiento de una MISA

"El ofrecimiento de la Misa por el descanso del alma de los fieles difuntos está vinculado con nuestra creencia en el Purgatorio. Creemos que si una persona ha muerto creyendo fundamentalmente en Dios, pero con pecados veniales y el dolor causado por el pecado, entonces Dios en su divino amor y misericordia purificará primero el alma. Después de que se haya completado esta purificación, el alma tendrá la santidad y pureza necesarias para participar en la visión beatífica en el cielo. Mientras cada individuo comparece ante el Señor para ser juzgado y rendir cuentas de su vida, la comunión de la Iglesia compartida en esta tierra continúa, excepto para aquellas almas condenadas al infierno. El Concilio Vaticano II afirmó: "Este sagrado Concilio acepta lealmente la venerable fe de nuestros antepasados en la comunión viva que existe entre nosotros y nuestros hermanos que están en la gloria del cielo o que todavía se purifican después de su muerte..." (Constitución Dogmática sobre la Iglesia, No. 51). Por lo tanto, así como oramos unos por otros y compartimos las cargas de los demás ahora, los fieles en la tierra pueden ofrecer oraciones y sacrificios para ayudar a las almas difuntas que pasan por la purificación, y no podría ofrecerse mejor oración que la del Santo Sacrificio de la Misa."
