Power: There will be 110/20amp service. Trucks and vendors requiring 30-50amp service should be prepared to have their own 85dcbl max noise rated generators and be self-contained. Note any power or special requirements here:

Set Up: Friday 12pm – 7pm and Saturday 7am-9am. Show Hours: Saturday 11AM-7pm. Vendors will have event admission passes and/or wristbands for staff. All food vendors must be in place on Saturday by 9am or designated arrival times. (Exceptions only by approval of the Food Coordinator.) Arrival times are critical as food vendors will be located WITHIN the event-controlled security fencing area.

Food vendors that do not have a Kendall County annual permit are required to have 3-day temporary food vending permit (\$20). (We will register and pick up permits for you.) Food Vendors must submit a signed copy of Kendall County Temporary Food Establishment Permit and Compliance form (located on website) with their application. All applications with fees are due no later than March 10th or \$25.00 late fee will apply. (10% of sales will be collected at the close of show.) A copy of the vendor proof of liability insurance should be included.

Cancellation Policy: No refunds for vendor cancellations after March 1st, 2019.

Canopies must be weighted down or secured with screw in stakes such as pet stakes. NO HAMMERED DRIVEN STAKES ALLOWED. Vendors are to park personal vehicles in designated vendor parking on Friday and will need vendor vehicle passes for workers on Saturday. Vendor breakdown or parking within the AgriCULTURAL prior to 7pm on Saturday is prohibited. Mis-parked vehicles are subject to ticketing or towing at owners' expense. Observe all traffic signs. The perimeter of the event site will be fenced with limited access.
