- Voluntary donations to the Library and Building Funds, which are tax deductible.

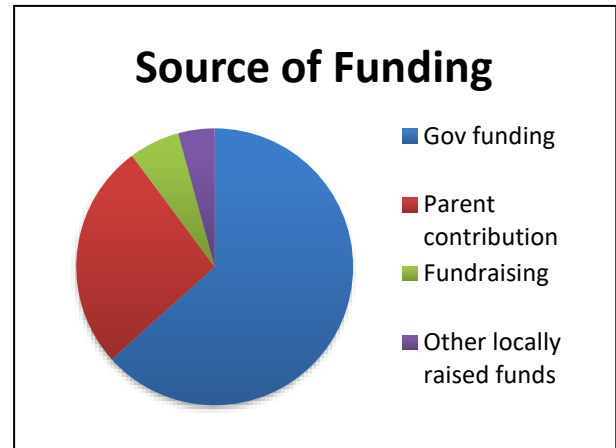
To help your understanding of each component, each is described further, on the back of this letter.

The percentages and sources of income to operate the school are illustrated in the chart below. It is evident that parent contributions are vital.

Your contributions will help to ensure that our facilities, teaching resources, educational programs, teacher development programs and IT systems remain at the standard required to support the school's efforts to provide our children with the best possible primary school education. We continue to upgrade our grounds, maintain our buildings to a high standard and purchase new furniture to support our positive learning and attractive environments. Continued support will ensure that all of this is able to be sustained.

Tax deductible donations to our Library and Building Funds are particularly important again this year. Continued donations to these funds will help fund future projects.

After strong positive feedback from many parents, this year we will again be group purchasing the essential education items (including the Starter Pack). The pack will be **available for collection in the Library from 3pm to 6pm on Wednesday, 27th November, 2019. Payments must be made via Compass Course Confirmation by 22nd November, 2019, in order for the packs to be available for collection.**

If you have any difficulty meeting the requested costs, we have set up a payment plan on Compass to assist you. The payments will be split in three with the first instalment occurring on 22nd November, 2019 the second instalment will occur on 10th February, 2020 and the third on 18th May, 2020. These amounts will be deducted from your nominated credit card.

2020 Parent Fees & Contributions – Description

Shared classroom supplies & specialist curriculum program materials (payment mandatory)

This covers the cost of books and classroom materials used by your child. It supplements the minimum standard funded by DET contributions. Our school provides a broad range of additional programs to help your child prepare for the future, including art, performing arts, physical education, Japanese, robotics and the library.

Mathletics (Foundation to Year 4 - payment mandatory)

Mathletics is Australia's leading maths education package. More information can be found at www.mathletics.com.au We have negotiated a special rate of only \$15 per student, which compares very favourably with the standard charge of \$99 per student and the \$15 allows the students to use the program at both school and home.

Spellodrome (Foundation to Year 6 – payment mandatory)

Spellodrome is an engaging array of activities, games and challenges which increases students' confidence in spelling. Spellodrome encourages independent learning and the development of critical spelling awareness. Visual, Phonological, Morphemic and Etymological.

Maths Mate (Years 5 & 6 – payment mandatory)

Maths Mate forms part of the 5/6 area's weekly teaching and learning where students systematically revise all skills related to the key mathematical strands at their level. Emphasis is placed on the consolidation, revision and gradual development of basic concepts across a variety of areas so that students keep their skills up to date throughout the year.

Individual classroom supplies Starter Pack (payment mandatory)

This covers the cost of your child's individual stationery pack. In previous years, and again this year, we will purchase these packs in bulk through the school in order to reduce costs and ensure all students have the packs.

eBooks (payment mandatory)

Nelson's PM and Sunshine reading materials are internationally acclaimed resources which schools have used for many years. The school subscribes to their eCollections which have been re-designed for device compatibility that are able to be used at school for classroom activities and at home as part of our take home reading.

First Aid Officer

Our School Council employs a First Aid Officer to provide you peace of mind about your child's wellbeing and enables our teachers to focus on their important education role. There is a much higher incidence of children with allergies and medical conditions at the school which require specialised attention as well as the usual scrapes and illnesses. Please support us to provide this level of care to your children.

Information Technology

We are continuing to increase infrastructure and network availability for children. Unfortunately, DET provides minimal funding, hence it is important to supplement this to improve the standard of our ICT program. This levy pays for the maintenance, leasing and purchase of netbooks/notebooks, printers, televisions and the like, which in aggregate costs almost \$30,000 annually. In 2019 the school undertook a new leasing arrangement for the replacement of classroom netbooks/notebooks.

Grounds & Facilities Maintenance

These funds pay for a gardener and maintenance man, allowing us to continue to have well maintained gardens and buildings.

Library Fund (tax deductible)

Donations to the Library Fund enable us to buy more books and broaden the scope of resources available for your child. This is particularly important as we do have high turnover and endeavour to ensure material is of high quality. Next year we hope to continue purchasing a number of books to support the work we are undertaking in our Kids Matter Program.

Building Fund (tax deductible)

Donations to the Building Fund enable ongoing improvement of school facilities, carpets, painting, air conditioners and fixtures.
