Wanda was also a devoted member of Christ Community in Richardson, Texas. Known for her kindness, humility, and unwavering faith, she cared deeply for others and lived a life marked by service and compassion.

To honor her commitment to education and her impact in STEM, the Wanda M. Williams Book Award, Academic Scholarship and Tuition Assistance Scholarships were established. These awards support students pursuing degrees in:

Science – Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Geology, Statistics

Technology – Computer Science, IT, Cybersecurity, Software Development

Engineering – Electrical, Mechanical, Biomedical, Civil Engineering

Mathematics – Applied Mathematics, Statistics, Actuarial Science, Data Science

Complete application packet must be received no later than Sunday, May 31, 2026.

Applicant:

- Applicant must be a resident of the DFW Metroplex, as determined by student's permanent address.
- Applicant must be planning to, or currently enrolled in, an accredited college, university, or trade school studying one of the following STEM areas:
Science – Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Geology, Statistics
Technology – Computer Science, IT, Cybersecurity, Software Development
Engineering – Electrical, Mechanical, Biomedical, Civil Engineering
Mathematics – Applied Mathematics, Statistics, Actuarial Science, Data Science

Application Packet:

1. Completed application form
2. Most recent school transcript (unofficial transcript is acceptable)
3. Documentation demonstrating financial need for the **Wanda Marie Williams Tuition Assistance Scholarship**;
4. Most Recent Income Tax Return of parent or guardian or if applicable, of Primary Student as a Dependent on Income Tax Return
5. Submit completed application packet **by email** to: scholarships@letselevatedallas.org **or mail** to: Let's Elevate, Inc., Attn: Education Committee, 701 Centennial Blvd, Richardson, TX 75081.
6. Applications must be **received** by the deadline, Sunday, May 31, 2026, to qualify.

Selection Process:

1. Application packets will be reviewed and recommended by Let's Elevate, Inc.'s Education Committee and approved by the LEI Board of Directors in their sole discretion.
2. Awardees will be notified by the Education Committee by Wednesday June 3, 2026.

Award Process:

1. Scholarship recipients will write a letter or e-mail of request which should include the following:
 - Name/address of school or university planning to attend
 - Degree to pursue and major(s)
 - Name and address to which payment should be made if unable to receive in person.
2. **The scholarship will be awarded in the form of a check made payable to recipient during service at Christ Community on Sunday, June 7, 2026.**

Applicant must write a 300 word essay on why the receipt of this scholarship is important to the attainment of his/her STEM-related educational goals. The essay should also include what STEM related area they are matriculating in, what have been their challenges, and how this scholarship will benefit them.	Each scholarship awarded will be in the amount of \$1,000.
Wanda Marie Williams Book Scholarship	The Wanda Marie Williams Book Scholarships are awarded to approved students with a major in a STEM-related program, to assist with the purchase of books for their academic school year.	Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale at current or most recent school.	Applicant must write a 200 word essay sharing at least one or service in which they participate, to make a positive impact on their school or community.	Each scholarship awarded will be in the amount of \$500.
Wanda Marie Williams Tuition Assistance Scholarship	The Wanda Marie Williams Tuition Assistance Scholarships are awarded to approved students with a major in a STEM-related program.	Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale at current or most recent school. Need based.	Applicant must write a 500 word essay telling why his/her education is important and how it has been – or will be – used to benefit the community at large. The essay should also include what STEM related area they have an interest in and why.	Each scholarship awarded will be in the amount of \$1,000.
