### **Teacher's Note:**

Students will learn many techniques for creating a truly unique and stunning art piece, with multiple layers and textures of fabric. The student will create a base, covered with beautiful overlays of fabric, surrounded by shapes that extend outward, giving the piece added shape, dimension and excitement. There will be plenty of demonstrations, both technical and aesthetic. The final piece will hang on the wall. No sewing involved. Perfect for beginning through advanced artists!

# <u>Supply List:</u> (Please see the specific details below and follow them exactly)

#### Steam-A-Seam 2

- Three packages of 9"x12" "Steam-A-Seam 2" sheets, (with five sheets per package).
- This product can be ordered on Amazon, or other sites.
- Be sure to get "Steam-A-Seam 2 Double Stick Fusible Web" and NOT "Steam-A-Seam Lite."
- (Some fabric and craft stores sell this product in bulk, so you can buy it by the yard).
- o (You can also order a big roll, which will last a long time, but it's pricey).
- Do not substitute this product for any other iron-on adhesive. None of them work for this project except Steam-A-Seam 2.

#### Fabric scissors

#### Cardboard boxes

- Three of the same size Post Office Priority Mailboxes with this written on them:
  - Priority Mail, Medium Flat Rate Box, One Rate-Any Weight, ID: 11.875 x 3.375 x 13.625, OD: 12 x 3.5 x 14.125l

 Please get this exact size, and if they don't have it at the Post Office, get something as similar as possible to this size.

#### Fabric

 Have a variety of fabric to cut up, such as used clothing, trims, lace, crocheted pieces, pillowcases, place mats, fabric scraps, tablecloths, etc. The sky's the limit with this. Any type of fabric will work except thin silk.

#### Steam Iron

- o An iron without steam will not work, so be sure it's a hardy steam iron
- o (These are available at Costco, online, etc).

## Ironing board

o If you don't have one, simply place a towel over a large book

#### Pen

Any kind

#### Ruler

o 12" is fine
