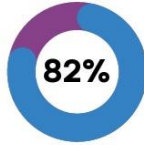

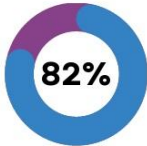
Of respondents said that they learned new information from the workshop



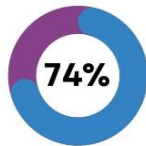
Said the event was accessible to their communication needs



Of respondents rated the Opioid Prevention workshop "Very Good" or "Good"



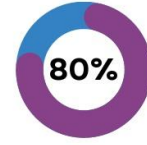
Of attendees said they would definitely share info from the workshop with someone else



Said they would definitely attend another event like this



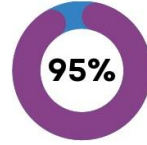
Of respondents said the information that they received was valuable
