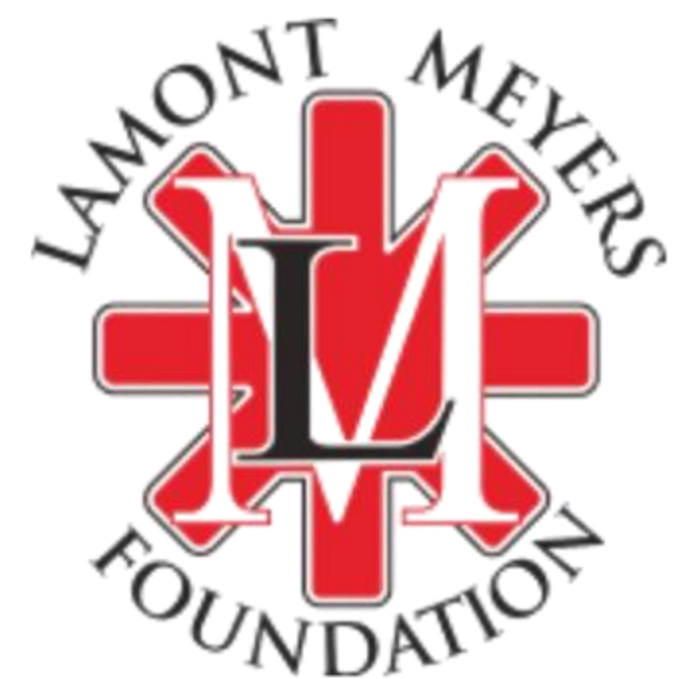

We are an 501c3 organization committed to safeguarding the well-being of our youth and individuals of all ages by addressing the pressing issue of drug overdose and usage.

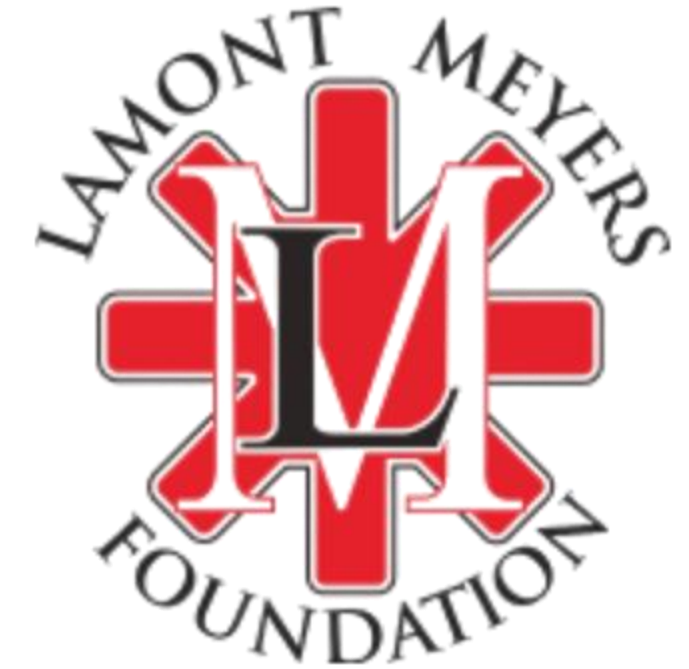






2nd Chance Kits

Giving Someone a Second Chance at Life



- Designed to **prevent overdose deaths** and **poisoning** by providing immediate harm reduction tools.
- Each kit includes:
 - Narcan (naloxone): reverses opioid overdoses and saves lives.
 - Fentanyl test strips: detect hidden fentanyl in pills, powders, or liquids.
 - Gloves, masks, and sanitizer: ensure safe response and infection prevention.
- Kits are free and accessible to community members, schools, families, and organizations.
- Part of LMF's mission to ensure no life is lost simply because resources weren't available.

Key Message:

"These kits are more than supplies—they are hope, protection, and a second chance at life."

Fentanyl and other substances can **affect anyone, any age**

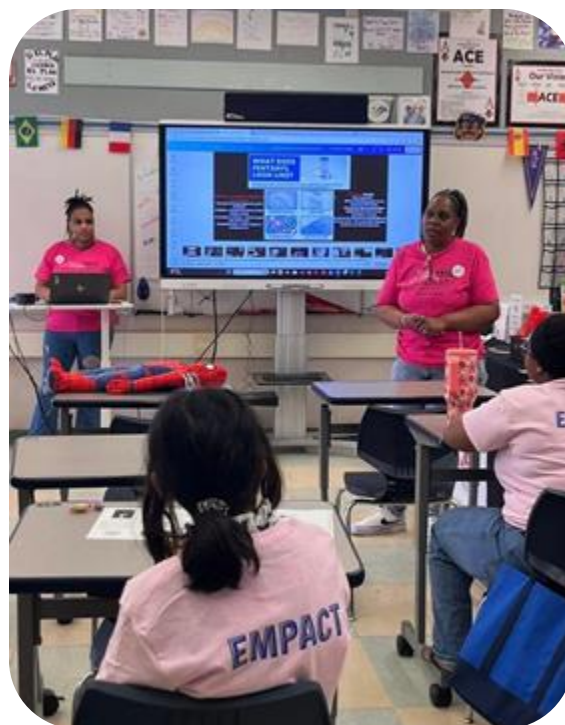

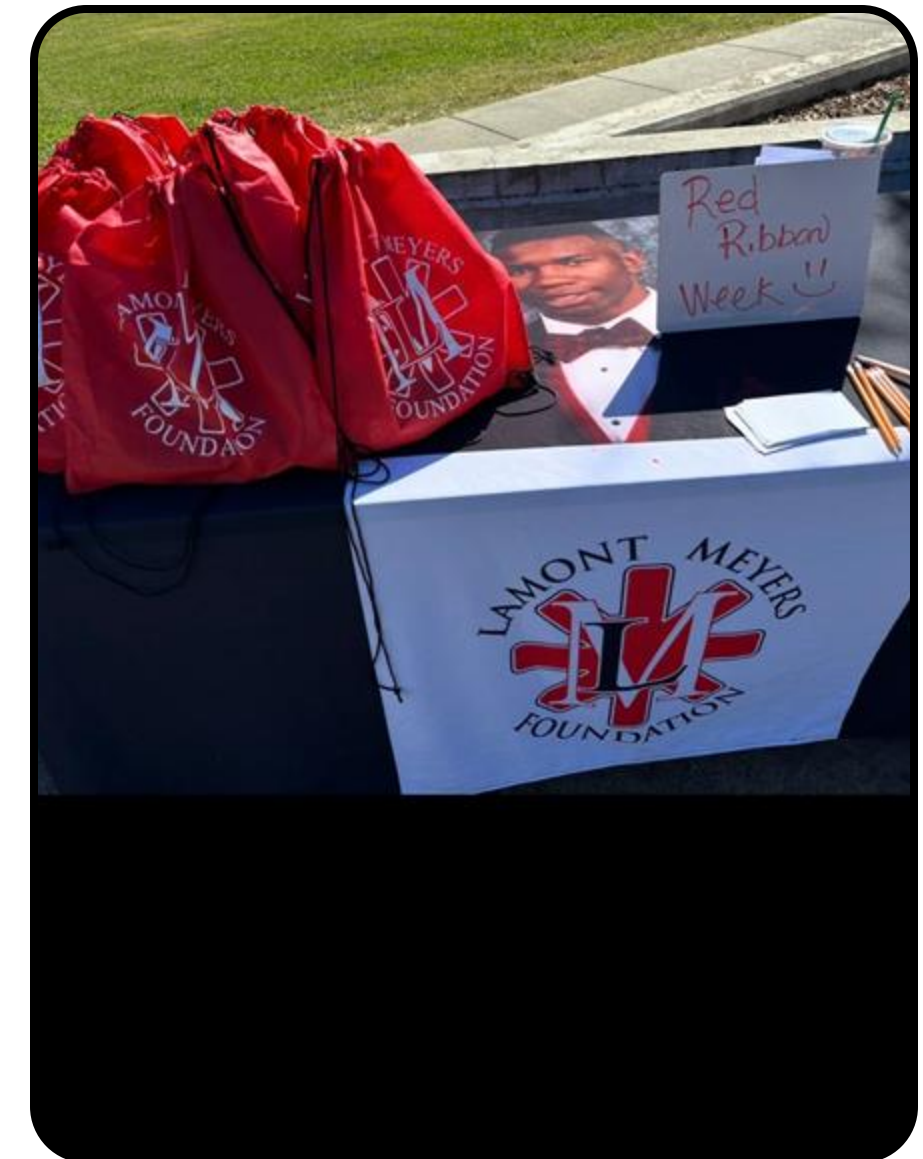
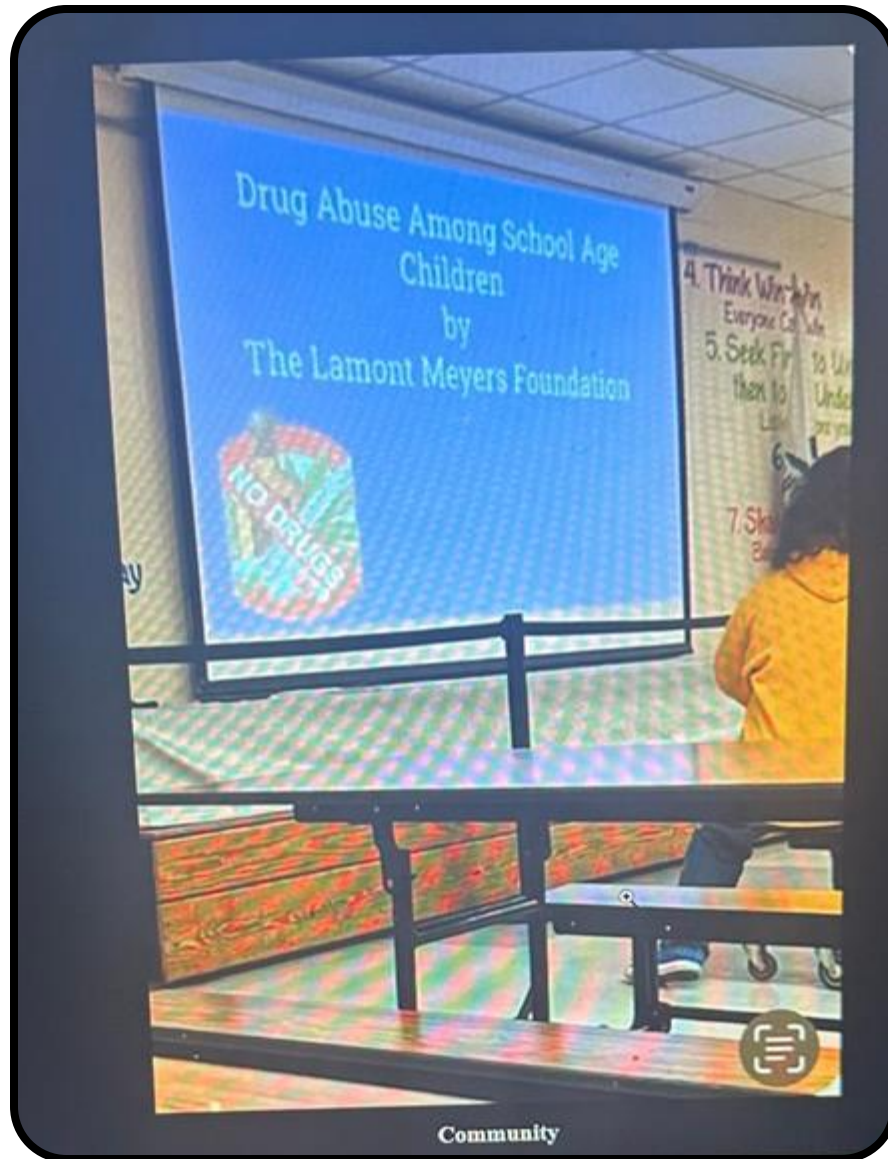
Our Work with Local Colleges...

- Learning about overdose prevention and harm reduction while helping others.



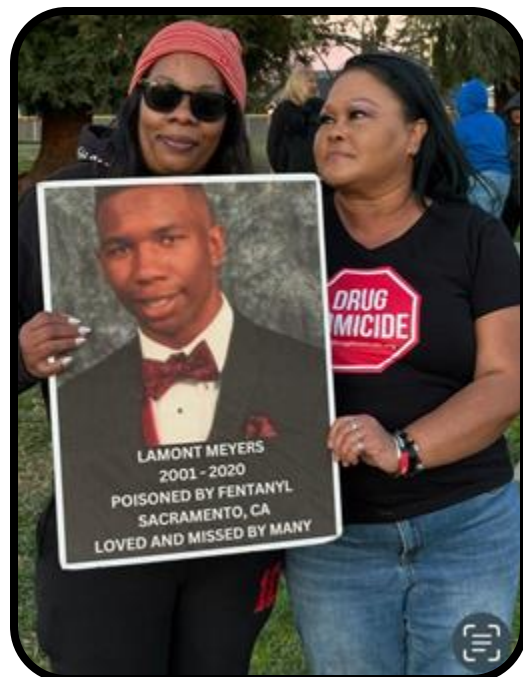

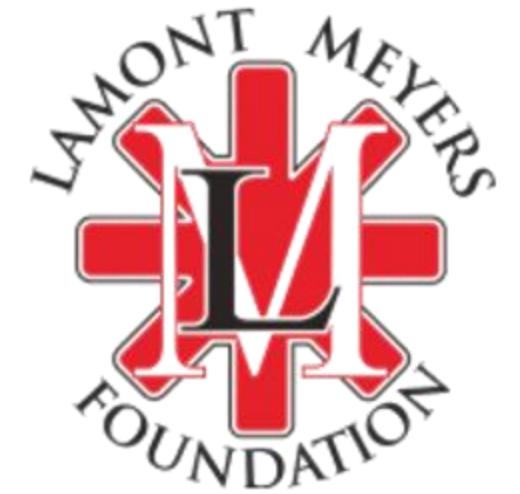


From Airwaves to Campaigns, it's a Collaboration!



Inclusive support for families impacted by drugs, overdose poisoning, community violence, and suicide.





Resource and Referral Assistance

- Connecting individuals and families to vital services such as counseling, treatment programs, senior and non-senior housing referrals, legal support, and emergency aid.
- SAMHSA National Helpline: Offers confidential, free help for individuals facing substance use disorders.
- Crisis Helpline: Provides immediate assistance for individuals in crisis.
- Mental Health Hotline: Connects individuals to mental health support services.
- Suicide Prevention Services: Offers support for individuals experiencing suicidal thoughts.
- Human Trafficking Hotline: Provides resources and support for victims of human trafficking.
- Elder Abuse & Neglect Hotline: Offers assistance for cases of elder abuse and neglect.
- TeachBLS.com (CPR): Provides CPR training and certification.
- YXPlosion: Offers distribution of goods, employment resources, housing, and medical services.
- Fighting Back Partnership: Provides basic needs, housing, mental health assistance, substance use education, and links to county programs.
- WEAVE: Offers support for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.
- California Youth Crisis Line: Provides support for youth in crisis.
- Bereavement Network Resources of Sacramento: Offers grief support services.
- Sacramento Mental Health Treatment Center: Provides mental health treatment services.

Support Services for Impacted Families in Tough Times

Helping families cope with the emotional, financial, and practical challenges

- **Emotional Support:** Connect families to counselors and mental health help.
- **Financial Relief (One-Time):** Provide groceries or food for one household (\$15–\$40 depending on available **funding**).
- **Emergency Resources:** Offer guidance and tools to get through tough situations.



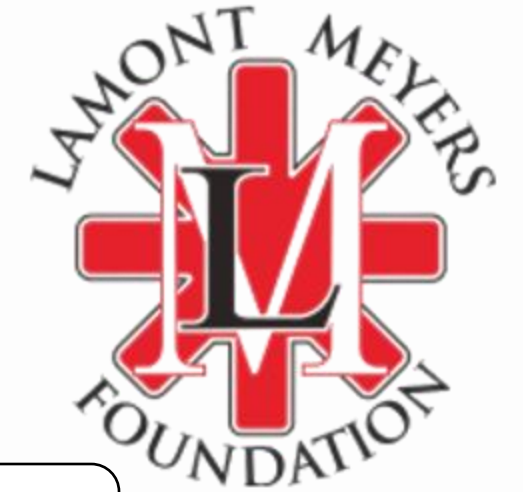

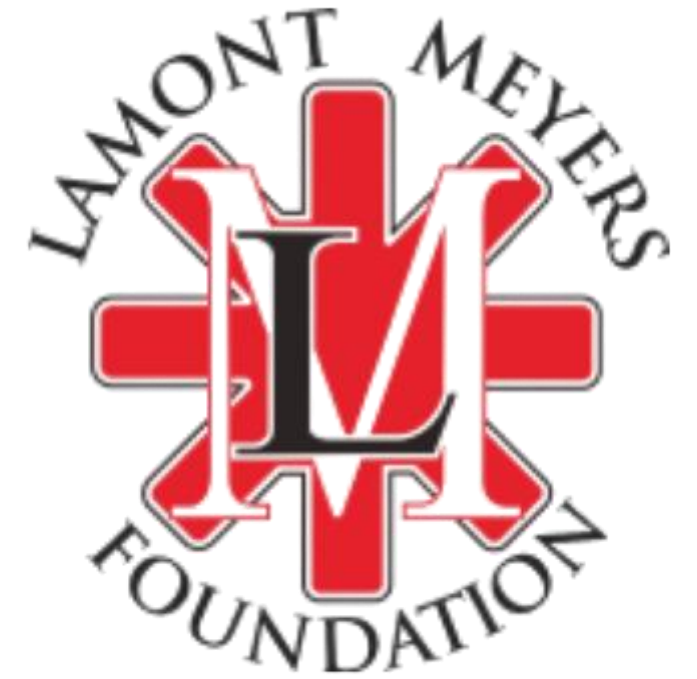
