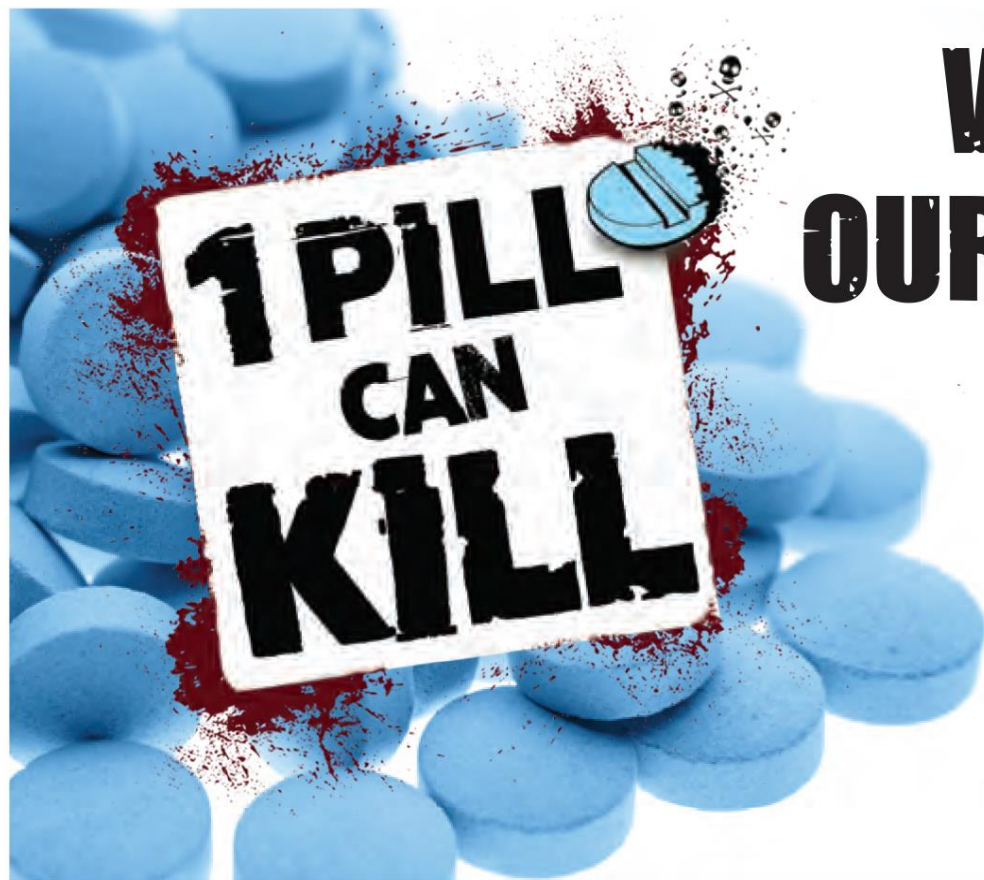

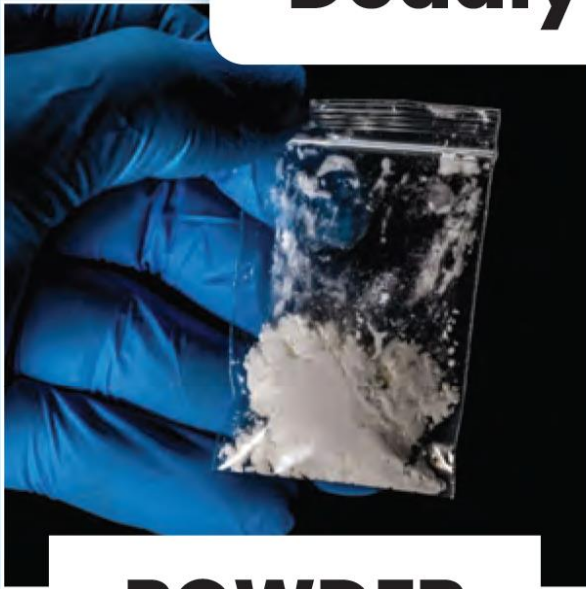


WE HAVE AN EPIDEMIC IN OUR COMMUNITY - IT'S CALLED **FENTANYL**

98% of those pills contained fentanyl.**

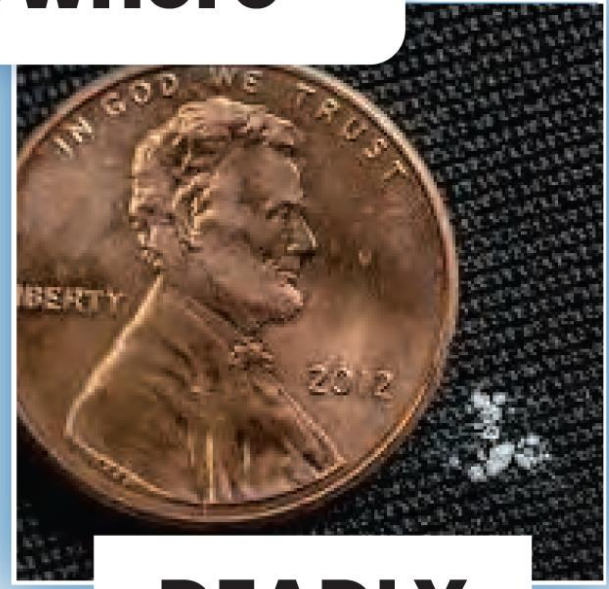
Deadly Fentanyl can hide anywhere

Signs of an Opioid Overdose

- ✓ Blue lips or nails
- ✓ Choking/snoring sounds
- ✓ Dizziness and confusion
- ✓ Can't be woken up
- ✓ Slow or no breathing
- ✓ Difficulty staying awake

Stay with the person until help arrives.

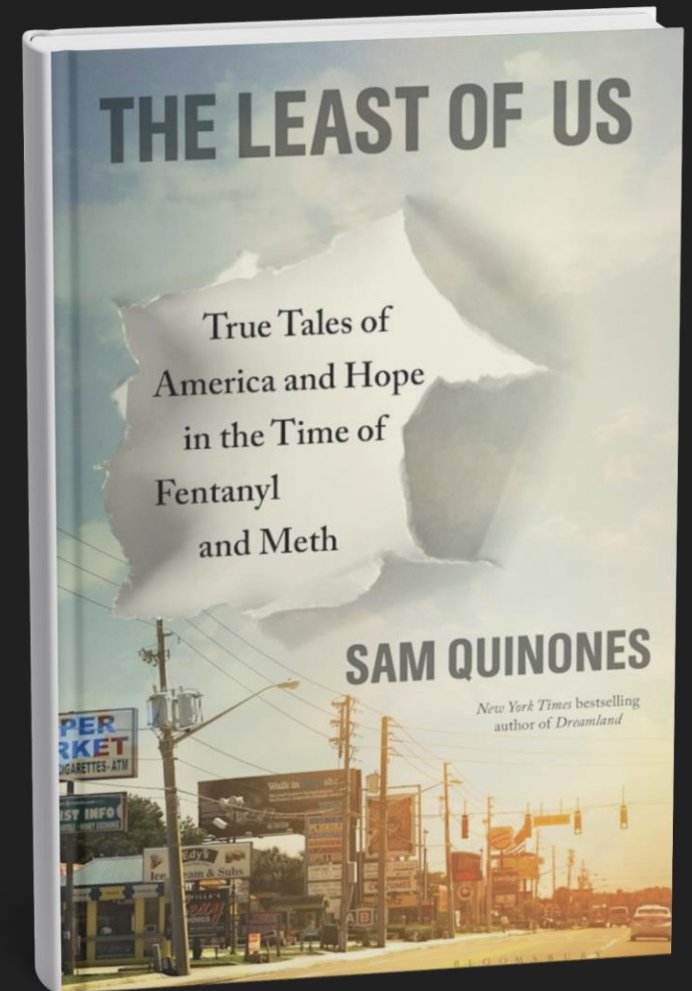
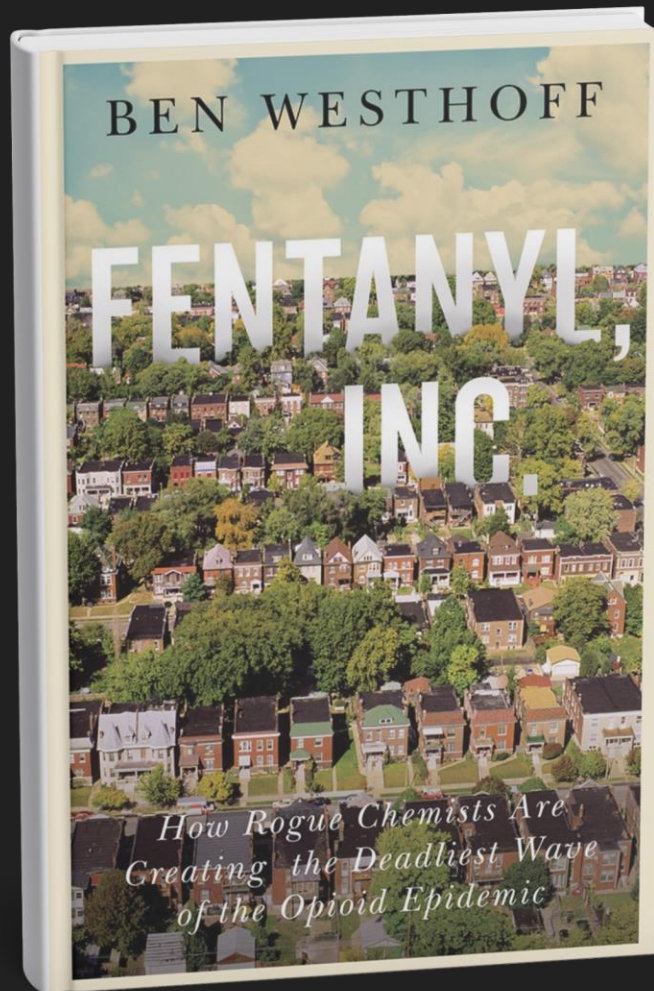
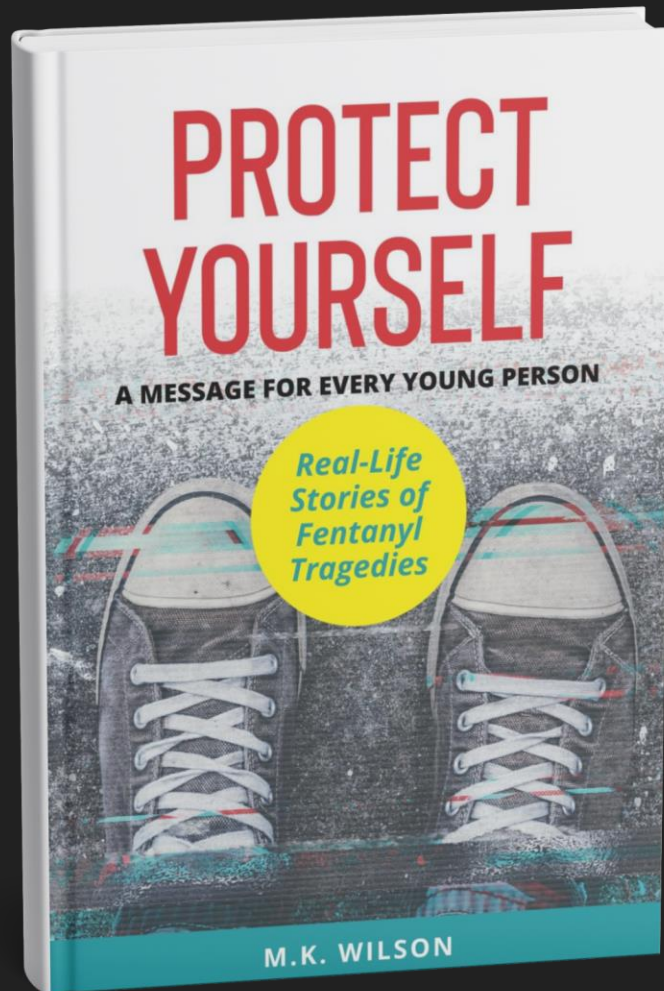
