

Sellers Obligation Regarding

Property Condition Disclosure

As the seller of residential real property, you are required by law to complete and sign a Property Condition Disclosure Statement as prescribed by Real Property Law 462(2) and cause it or a copy thereof, to be delivered to a buyer or a buyer's agent prior to the signing by the buyer of a binding contract of sale. A copy of the Property Condition Disclosure Statement containing the signatures of both the buyer and the seller must be attached to the real estate purchase contract.

If you acquire knowledge which renders materially inaccurate a Property Disclosure Statement previously provided, you must deliver a revise Property Disclosure Statement to the buyer as soon as practicable. In no event, however will you be required to provide a revised Property Condition Disclosure Statement, after the transfer of the title from you to the buyer or after the buyer has commenced occupancy of the property.
