Theodore Alexander boasts a robust domestic stocking program, offering quick lead times, prompt attention to requests, and service as individualized as its product.

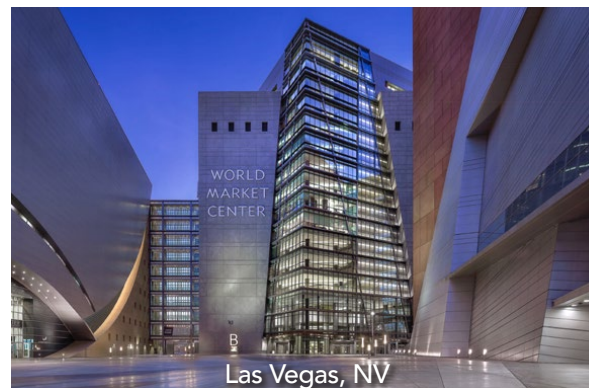


» Designer Showrooms

Alexa Hampton has served as a long-term collaborator with Theodore Alexander, designing bold casegoods, upholstery, occasional and accessories with her signature touches.



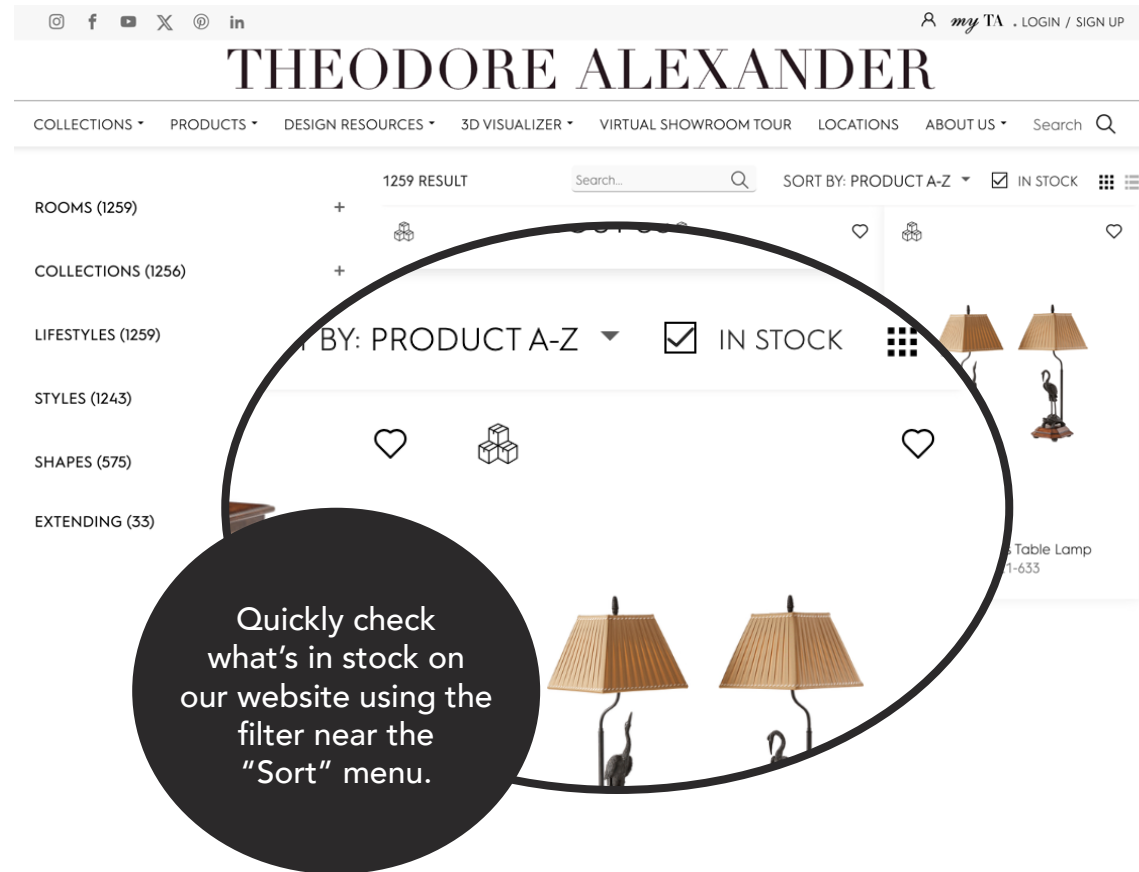
