Our March meeting consisted of repotting at Edwin Werner Park. We couldn't have asked for a nicer day to repot, and the mild weather this month will give all of our trees a great jumpstart in health. Thanks to everyone who

came out to repot trees and especially to those experienced members who came out to provide helpful tips and advice for repotting.





April - Care Calendar

Last frost

Avg. Low 47° Avg. High 70° Record Low 23° Record High 91°

Tree Talk:

During early spring, the trees are reaccumulating energy through photosynthesis. Trees are actively growing whenever temps are between 42° and 92°. Water needs continue to increase. We see fertilizer breaking down. Foliage continues to harden off as the leaves build their protective cuticles. Buds for the second flush are setting and swelling. Juniper tips are extending. Pine candles extending.

How to Respond:

Check for water needs 2X a day. Watch trees carefully for pests and diseases. Rotate trees 1/4 turn every week. If we are looking for smaller leaves or more ramification, we can partially defoliate after leaves have hardened off. Fertilize deciduous after leaves harden off. Apply 2nd round of organic fertilizer for evergreens that are still in development (working on primary branching). Fertilize newly repotted trees when we see new growth (usually 4-6 weeks).

Mentorship 101 - March


