January	Coldest Month Avg. Low :28° Avg. High: 46° Record Low: 17° Record High: 78°	Trees are dormant and using very little water. Some buds may begin to swell.	Great time to treat for over-wintering pests and diseases. Check once a week for water needs. Most trees that are mulched in, protected from wind and have been outside all winter can tolerate 14°- 18° temperatures by now.

Mentorship

Our Mentorship program is changing a little this year. We will still have Mentorship 101 which will run January, March, April, and May (1st Saturday of the month). The current class is still in progress and wraps up in May.

The third session of Mentorship 101 will be held at John's house from 10am-2pm on Saturday, January 5th. We will cover pot selection, make top dressing and make bamboo potting chopsticks. Students and mentors will not need to bring their tools. This class will cost \$25, for students, to cover the club's expenses for material. All NBS members are welcome to attend as observers. If observers want to take home bamboo potting chopsticks, the cost will be \$20. Dress warmly and bring a chair!



This year we will also have club Mentorship days for any members who wants to work on trees together. These will be in July, August and September (1st Saturday of the month). This will be a John Cole's nursery.

Finally, Eileen will host two four-hour sessions called All About Pines for NBS members who are interested in delving deeply into Single Flush and Multi Flush Pines. We will explore all facets of the species; potting, fertilizing, wiring, styling, diseases, pests and needle length reduction.

Bring your Single Flush Pines to the first session on Saturday, April 13th from 10am-2pm. Our Single Flush Pines are our Ponderosa Pines, Japanese White Pines, Limber Pines, Colorado Pines, Lodgepole Pines and Mugo Pines. We will work on our multi-flush pines in session two on Saturday June 15th from 10am-2pm. These include Japanese Black Pines, Red Pines, Virginia Pines, Pitch Pines and Loblolly Pines. The sessions are limited to six. Each four-hour session will cost \$50. You may enroll in one or two sessions. If you have questions or would like to register, please contact Eileen.
