May Meeting:





For our May meeting, Owen will discuss the use of native deciduous material as bonsai. Tennessee and the SouthEast in general are great areas for yamadori collection and offer many species that may be suitable for bonsai, but

not in widespread use as of yet. Owen will talk about his experiences in developing native material as it compares to more "traditional" bonsai species. You won't want to miss this one!

	<u>Tree Talk</u>	How to Respond
Wettest month Avg. Low 57° Avg. High 77° Record Low 34° Record High 96°	Rapid growth of foliage and new branches. Fertilizer breaking down rapidly. Trees taking up lots of water. All systems are up and running at full tilt by the end of the month. Most leaves have grown a waxy cuticle to help protect from sun, wind and diseases. Lots of insect activity in the garden.	Watch for BUGS & DISEASES. The combination of heat and wet create prime conditions for the spread of diseases. Manage foliage once it has hardened off and energy is reaccumulated. This helps to stimulate interior and lateral foliage growth. All trees have moved out of their winter dormancy and are putting on growth. Continue to fertilize and monitor for water needs. Air layer. Continue to feed organic fertilizer.
