




September Meeting:

Tree Talk

Temperatures begin to drop and daylight shortens. The trees begin to take up more water. As the trees move from summer dormancy into their fall vascular growth, we will to see wounds healing and branches fattening quickly.

How to Respond

Water needs are increasing so check trees often.
Apply 1st round of fall fertilizer when water uptake increases.
Check wires weekly as branches add girth. Allow most foliage to grow unchecked. Good time to work juniper.
