The Kennewick Kiwanis Foundation is offering scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year. The purposes of all available scholarships are to provide assistance for high school seniors enrolling in trade schools or institutions of higher education in the fall term of 2023. Both \$2,000 per year and \$1,000 per year scholarships are available with winners announced by mid-May 2023. The Foundation scholarship awards are cash awards paid in your name to the institution of your choice, based upon your confirmed enrollment. The Foundation offers both one-time and four-year renewable scholarships.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The student:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior from a certified high school affiliated with the Kennewick or Finley School Districts and lives in Kennewick, WA.
- 2. Must be enrolled in an institution of higher education by the fall term of 2022.
- 3. Must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher, based on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- 4. Must show evidence of leadership and participation in community service activities.
- 5. Must show financial need.

The committee members will evaluate applicants as follows:

a.	Scholastic Record	10%	d. Leadership	10%
b.	One Page Essay	10%	e. Service	15%
c.	Personal References	10%	f. Need	45%
