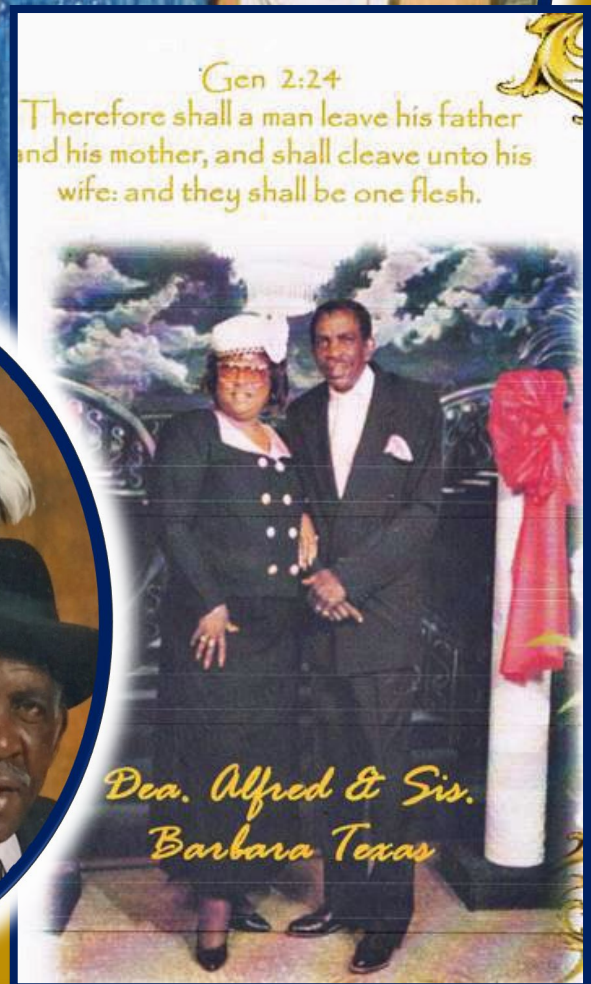
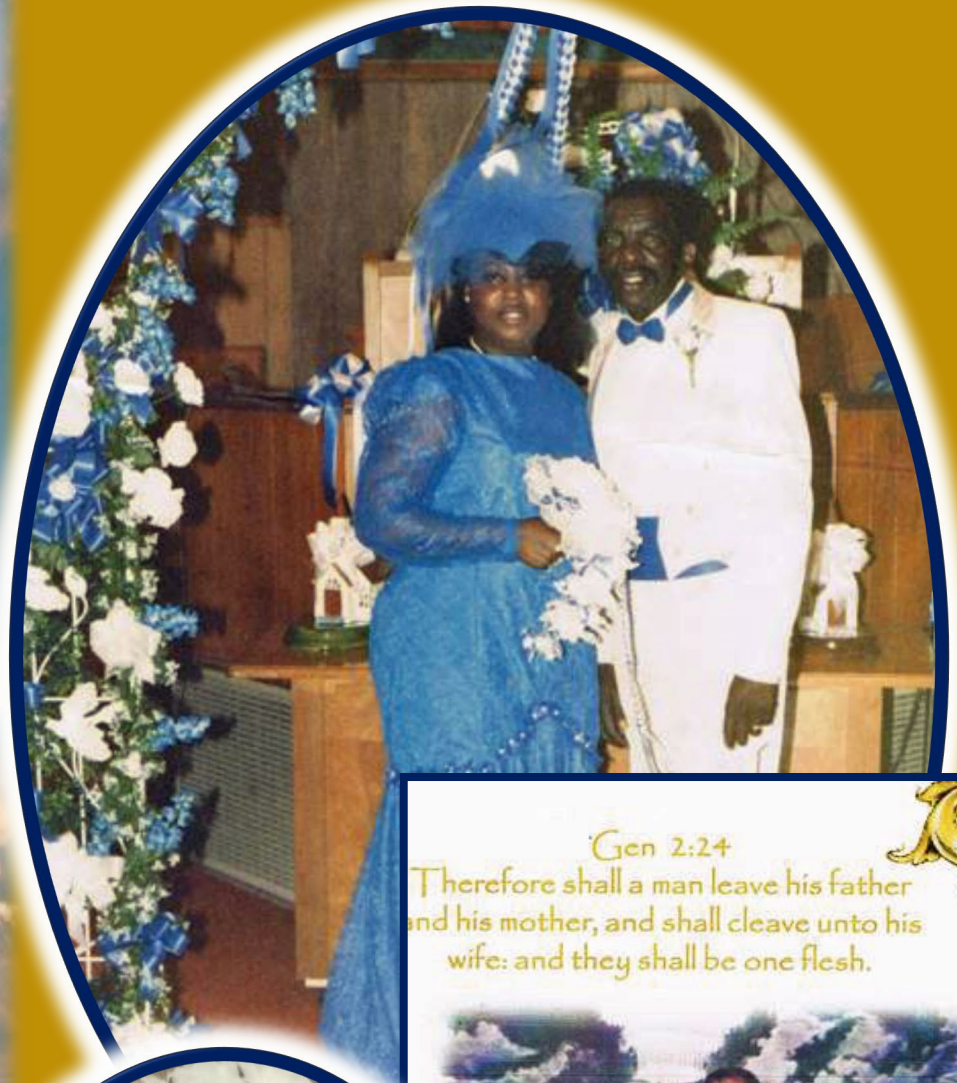
Tribute to My Husband

That came When I Lost You.

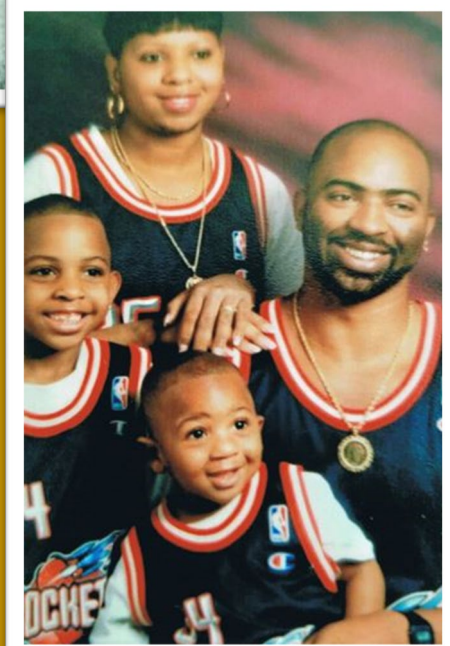
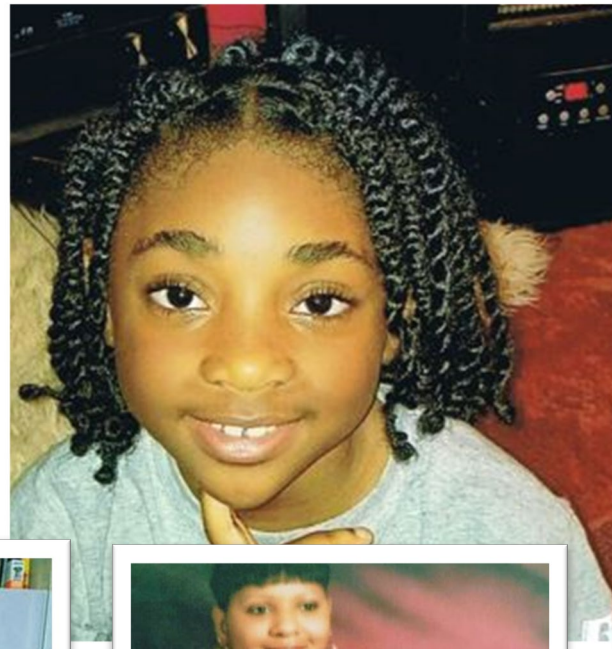

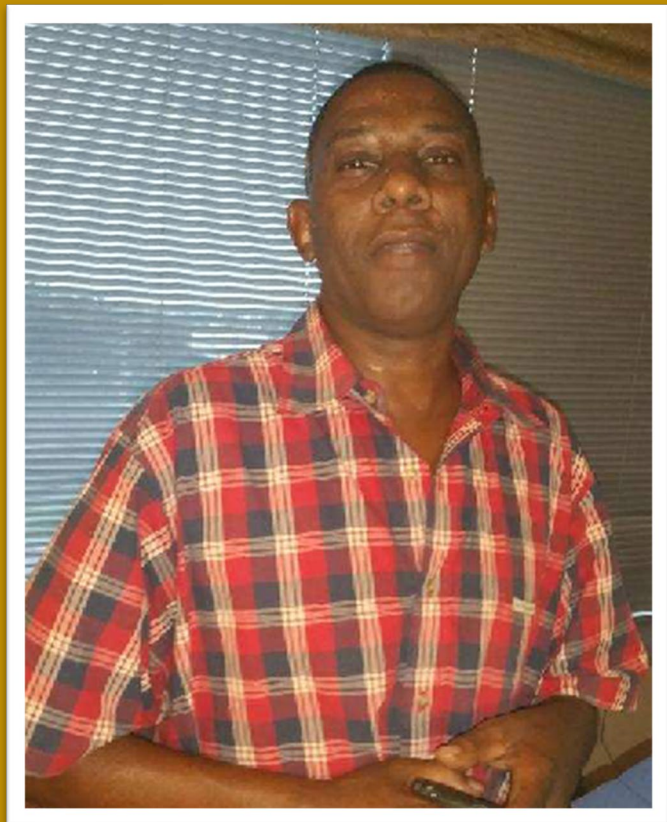
