How to measure your project

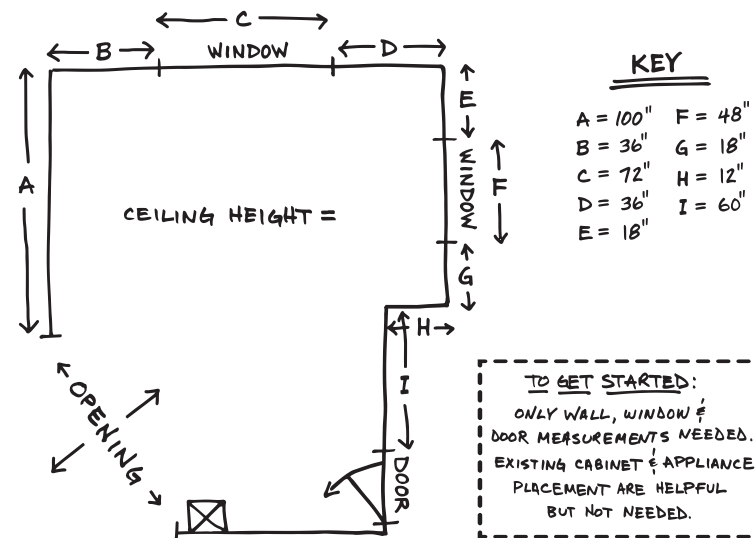

Once you have the dimensions and a rough sketch of your space, copy the information to the grid sheet provided.

Step One:

Draw your space and make detailed notes. Be sure to include any structural features or obstacles such as appliances, doors, windows, outlets, soffits, etc... Don't forget the ceiling height!

Step Two:

Transfer your sketch to our grid sheet and fill out our door & window chart. Feel free to add notes / ideas you have on appliance placement or any desired accessories you'd like to add.

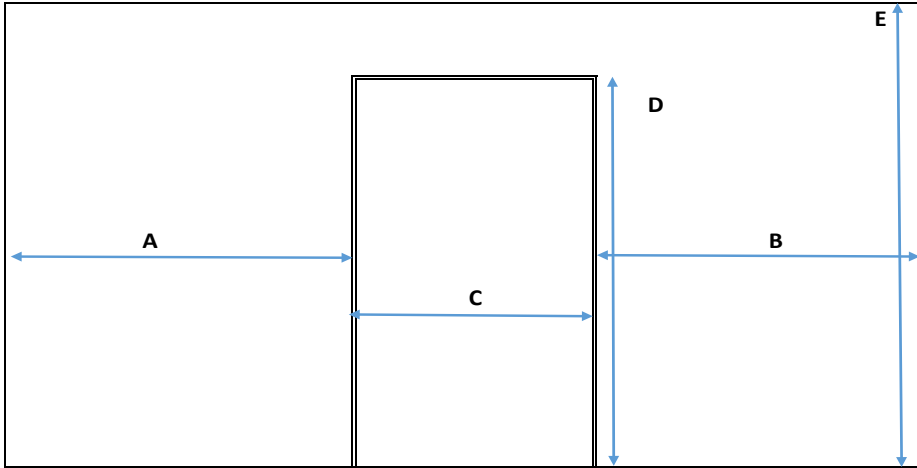
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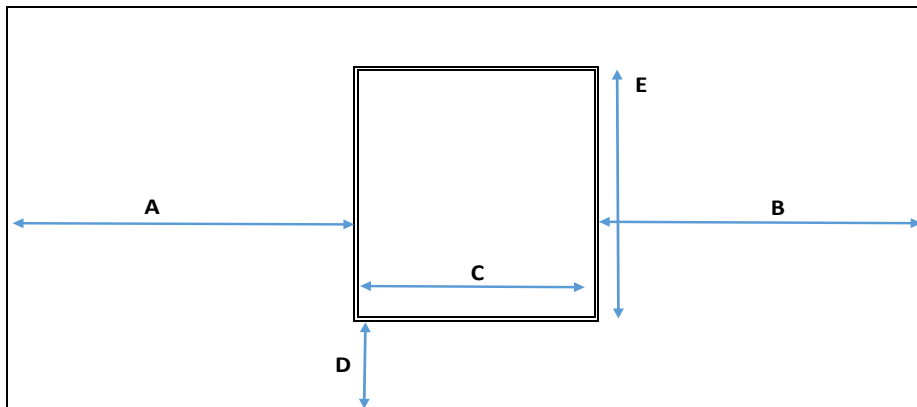


Door & Window Measurement Sheet
