SAFETY ZONE

Do you know how far you should park from a stop sign in the neighborhood? Pennsylvania law requires **at least 30 feet between a stop sign** and a car parked next to the intersection.

The weather is warming up and we have a lot of neighbors walking, some with strollers or pets, and children riding their bikes in the street. Parking the proper distance from intersections allows better visibility for drivers to see pedestrians. *Please help keep our community stay safe and keep the intersections and crosswalks clear.*

Also, the proper distance to park from a fire hydrant is 15 feet.

Pool Opening! Sat. May 24 All Ages

Our community pool will be open from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend. From May 24-June 15, the pool will only be open on Saturdays and Sundays. From June 18-Sept. 1, the pool will be open 7 days a week. Daily hours are 12PM-8PM.

To get your pool tags, mark your calendars for pickup at the Clubhouse on April 27 (1-3PM) or May 3 (12-2PM). Residents are required to have pool stickers affixed to their pool tags. Residents are reminded to keep your pool tags from previous seasons (it helps us save money) and we'll issue new stickers for the current season.

Bring a **photo ID** with proof of current Tyler Walk address (driver's license or utility bill). Only residents in good standing are permitted to use the pool, so you must be current on your quarterly dues payments to obtain a sticker. Check your email for a form to fill out ahead and bring with you for quicker distribution. Only two (2) guest passes per address are permitted.

SAFETY TIPS

Keep these tips in mind as you and your family enjoy the warmer weather.

Grills. Grills should be placed at least 3 feet away from your home or anything that can burn, including siding and deck railings. Be sure to move grills out from under eaves and overhanging branches.

Keep an eye on your grill. Don't leave grills unattended when lit. Clean your grill after each use as this will remove grease that can start a fire.

Stormwater Drains. Never dump anything down stormwater drains, including soap, oil and grease from a car wash in your driveway. These drains empty directly into local waterways without being treated, so anything entering storm drains will flow into streams and creeks. Remember, the drain is just for rain.

Arbor Awareness. Now is a good time to look around and trim any hanging branches that may fall. Also, be sure to pull any sprouting seedlings that may have fallen from a bird or the wind before they become a bigger expense to remove.



TYLER TALK

Be Alert for Fraud! Fraud is becoming more difficult to detect, which means you need to always be on guard. Fraudsters attempt to target you by email, phone, and text. They can disguise their phone numbers to look like your bank or a friend is calling you.

Always be aware of any suspicious or unusual attempts to access your personal information, whether it's account information, your social security number or birthdate. Most companies will never call, text or email to ask for sensitive information such as passwords, account numbers or one-time passwords. Additional signs to be alert for include an unexpected problem or prize offer, pressure to act immediately, or a request for an unusual payment like gift cards or cryptocurrency.

When in doubt, hang up and don't respond. Instead, call your bank using a verified contact number and speak with a customer service representative to verify any issues and report fraud.
