

Doorstep Crime



How do I protect myself from doorstep crime?

Follow the steps below:


- 1. DON'T DEAL WITH ANY COLD CALLERS!
- 2. Use our 'No Cold Callers' sticker in your window or on your door.
- 3. If you have a door spy-hole, check who is at the door before opening it
- 5. Don't trust the ID presented, it may be fake. Don't use the contact number on the ID to check if it is valid.
- 6. Close the door when checking the caller. If they say they are from the council, police or utility company use the contact number on any bills/correspondence/back of this leaflet to check if they are genuine.
- 7. Set up a password with utility companies that they must use when visiting your home.
- 8. Don't respond to leaflet drops or phone cold calls.
- 9. Don't let strangers into your home. If they need help, call the authorities for them, but don't let them in.

Don't feel embarrassed to say no to people at your door and not let them in.

Help and Advice

Doorstep Crime - No Cold Calling

Doorstep crime refers to rogue traders, bogus callers and distraction burglary. Whilst we do have genuine callers at our doors there are unfortunately those that exploit

This includes people that knock on your door, phone calls, leaflets that raque traders put through the letterbox and false use of logos to appear genuine.

What are uninvited doorstep callers?

These 'salespeople/traders' show up unannounced and try to pressure you into getting work done on your house, such as fixing your roof, driveway, gutters, or trees. They often claim they're working in the neighbourhood and can offer you a super

You may also get 'Nottingham Knockers/Duster sellers who claim to be part of a rehabilitation scheme to try and sell household cleaning products. Not only are they trying to sell you poor quality items at highly inflated prices, they are also checking our

Not sure? Don't open the door.

Never deal with cold calling doorstep traders.

Report any suspicious activity online at cheshire.police.uk or by calling 101. If a crime is happening now, or there is a threat to life, dial 999.




