Boarding/Training Contract

_____, the Client, hires by contract **Moss Bend Retrievers, LLC** (hereafter referred to as “Moss Bend Retrievers”) for the purpose of training _____(dog).

(A) TRAINING FEE: Moss Bend charges a monthly training fee of \$850 for each dog listed above. The fee for the first month is due at the time of dog drop-off. In addition to this monthly charge, Moss Bend will charge a one time bird fee of \$100 at the beginning of your dogs training program. Invoices will be sent monthly and will be due upon receipt. In return for payment, Moss Bend will train dog(s) listed above.

(B) FEEDING: Moss Bend feeds Provider dog food for all dogs in training unless specialized feed is required. Specialized feed will be provided by the client at their expense.

i. Moss Bend will adjust feeding portions on an as needed basis to ensure that the contracted dog(s) maintain a healthy weight.

(C) TOOLS AND TECHNIQUES: Client understands the tools and techniques that are used to train and modify the behavior of their dog and agrees to the use of these tools and techniques which may include an electronic training collar, slip lead, and trained retrieve.

(D) VETERINARY CARE: Moss Bend will, on a routine basis, inspect dog(s) for injury or sickness. Proper veterinary care will be sought in the case that it is deemed necessary by Moss Bend. The client authorizes needed veterinary care by signing this contract. Client also agrees to reimburse all medical service and

medicine fees if not paid at time of service direct to vet by client over the phone or in person. Payment of these fees will be due as soon as service is complete and will be invoiced day off.

(E) VACCINATIONS: The client is responsible for having all vaccinations (rabies, parvovirus, distemper, and bordatella) current on their dog(s). The client will provide documented proof on or before the time the dog arrives at Moss Bend. State law requires the vaccinations and that documented proof is available for each dog.

(F) HEARTWORM AND FLEA/TICK PREVENTION: Moss Bend provides monthly heartworm treatment included in training fee. Flee/Tick medication is to be provided by owner/client and Moss Bend will administer at no charge.

(E) VISITATION: The client agrees to leave their dog in the care of Moss Bend for the entirety of the program, so as not to hinder training progress. This also ensures that illnesses cannot be contracted outside of the Moss Bend's facility. Moss Bend does recommend visitation during the training program but is permitted by appointment only and is not recommended before day 45 of training.

(F) BUSINESS HOURS: Moss Bend has regular business hours on weekdays (Monday through Friday) of 8:00am to 5:00pm. Moss Bend will schedule pick ups and drop offs by appointment on Saturdays, and only if times are available. Moss Bend will not have business hours on Sundays and holidays. The dogs in the care of Moss Bend will receive regular care 7 days a week.

- i. The Client agrees to contact Moss Bend to notify them of any pick up or drop off at least one (1) day in advance. Moss Bend staff trains dogs in several different locations and may not be at the kennel facility to meet with the client if no prior notice is given.
- ii. Any pick-ups that will require the trainer/owner to be present will be scheduled in advance on a day/time that fits the schedule of the trainer(s).

(G) HOLD HARMLESS: The client will hold Moss Bend free and harmless from any and all claims, liability, damage, loss, or expenses arising out of any injury to

any person or to any person's property by the dog(s) named in this contract, while in the care, custody and control of Moss Bend.

(H) PHOTOGRAPHY AGREEMENT: Owner grants Moss Bend and its representatives the right to take photographs of the dog and agrees that Moss Bend may use such photographs with or without the dog's name and for any lawful purpose, including for such purposes as publicity, illustration, advertising, and web content.

(I) HUNT TEST/FIELD TRIAL EXPENSES: If the client requests/agrees that the dog(s) participate in Hunt Test/Field Trial events under the handling of Moss Bend the following will apply: Client will reimburse monthly all entry fees incurred by Moss Bend. Also, a \$80 fee for handling/transportation will apply for each dog.

(J) LIABILITY LIMITATION: The client acknowledges that it is accepted that dog training will not provide exact results. Each dog is different in regard to ability, intelligence and temperament. Moss Bend makes no expressed, nor implied guarantee to the results reached in training or to the level of competency reached by contracted dog(s). Moss Bend reserves the right to terminate this training contract at any time, and to request that the client pick up his dog(s). All pre-paid training fees will be refunded on a daily pro-rated basis in the event that Moss Bend would make said request.

i. The client accepts that this is a training contract and that Moss Bend is not an insurer of the condition of the dog(s) while it is in the custody of Moss Bend. Moss Bend is in no way responsible for the cost of replacing contracted dog(s) or for any damage of any kind,

should contracted dog(s) die, be stolen, escape, run away, become injured, or become ill while in the care of Moss Bend. Proper care will be given and generally accepted training methods will be followed while dog(s) is under contract.

- ii. Client accepts that training can be dangerous, and injury or death can occur, even when careful measures have been taken.
- iii. Client acknowledges that boarding environments can pose risk of illness to the dog. Moss Bend cleans and sanitizes kennel spaces, food bowls, and

water buckets, on a regular basis, but cannot prevent 100% of illness. In the event that the dog(s) becomes ill while in Moss Bend's care, staff will treat dog(s) as recommended by a veterinarian.

- iv. In the rare and unfortunate event that your dog dies in our care, your dog will be taken to your designated veterinarian and maintained for pick-up or further instruction.

(K) With the permission of the Client, dog(s) can spend time playing/exercising with other dogs in the care of Moss Bend.

(L) SOLE AGREEMENT: This contract is the sole agreement between the client listed and Moss Bend. Any prior agreements, promises, negotiations, or representations not expressed in this contract are no longer in force or effect. Exception being additional terms agreed upon as listed below.
