Thus, no refund will be available after February 2<sup>nd</sup>. The program will only be able to take a maximum of 30 participants on this trip, so the first 30 participants paid into the program will be considered the participants in the program. There will be a waiting list for participants not considered the first 30, and those participants should make regular payments. In the event a participant on the waiting list is not moved up to one of the 30 participants, due to another participants dropping out, they will receive a full refund by March 4<sup>th</sup>.
