Burnett County is experiencing an alarming increase in applications for high-density RV campgrounds on its most valuable asset – the lakes!

Say NO to the proposed RV campground expansion on the former Houman's Resort Property on the Minerva Chain of Lakes

The Minerva Chain is part of a 26-lake ecosystem that will experience permanent water degradation if the number of people residing on Gull Lake **DOUBLES** through the addition of this expanded RV campground.

- Houman's property is home to 18 mobile homes & 13 cabins; proposal will increase to 89 campers & 12 condos
- Tenants in these RV campgrounds **do not pay property taxes** but strain the infrastructure & County services
- RV Campgrounds lower nearby property values
- Rural township roadways and bridges are not designed for the increased density of traffic
- Emergency services and law enforcement are not provided with extra funds to cover the additional burden
