Nelson Campground is a high-density, 180-unit site being proposed for Town of Swiss (north of Danbury) on January 5, 2021.

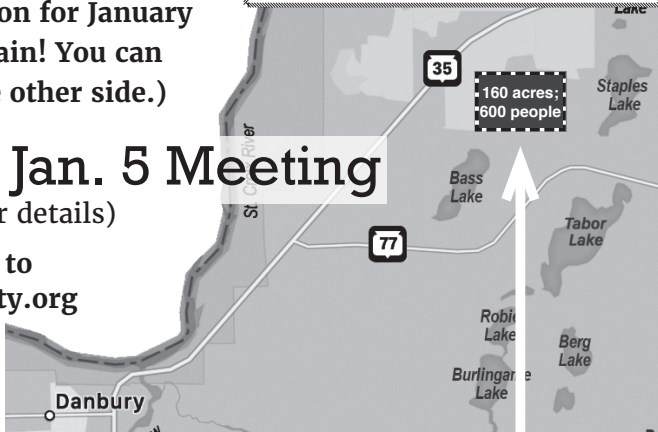

A Conditional Use Permit is required from the Burnett County Land Use & Information Committee to proceed. That request was originally scheduled for November 3. It was postponed because you are talking about it.
