






# RV Park Growth in Burnett County

Burnett County is home to 27 “campgrounds.” Most of these are actually RV parks, hosting park models with sheds, decks and storage areas -- and that require *annual contracts*. In 2015, there were **1,100 spots** available. Since then, **5 new RV parks and expansions** at existing “campgrounds” have resulted in more than **1,800 spots available – an increase of 60%**. Meanwhile, 2020 saw a loss of 25 overnight campground units -- with more to come.
